II. Announcements:

III. Report

The following points were discussed:

Agenda – 1 (Planning of FDP and Staff welfare Activities)

Discussions were held to organize FDPs and staff welfare activities to enhance the skills and knowledge base of faculty members. Announcement of FDP on data science was a strong initiative in that direction. Realizing the potential of faculty members, IQAC decided to organize more events and activities in line with the same.

Agenda – 2 (Increase Student Centric awareness activities)

To enhance the earning potential and emotional quotient of the students, IQAC decided to organize events in collaboration with WDC to sensitize students on various social issues. Keeping this as a

central theme, an awareness program for youth with regards to crimes was organized on 19th November, 2019 in association with Raigad District Police. More such events were recommended to be organized in the meeting.

Agenda – 3 (Research activities for faculty members and students)

One day National Conference on "Recent Trends in Interdisciplinary Research in Basic Sciences" to be held on 23 November, 2019. Faculty members were encouraged to present papers for the same. Planning of organizing a student seminar to inculcate research culture was also discussed and finalized by IQAC. The event was to be organized in December, 2020.

Agenda – 4 (One day field visits)

Department-wise one day field visits planning was discussed. The visits were scheduled before Christmas holidays as per convenience of respective companies or industries.

Agenda – 5 (AQAR documentation and uploading in NAAC website)

With regard to data compilation for AQAR, criterion in-charges and respective team members were asked to meet regularly with IQAC to discuss and finalize the same. The inputs are to be collected and verified by IQAC as soon as it receives the documents from various criterion in charges in accordance with the timelines given.

The concepts of Positive Psychology Sessions were finalized and allotted to IQAC members for designing the modules of 3 concepts – Stress Management, Talent Management and Personality Management.
