II. Announcements:

III. Report

The following points were discussed

Agenda – 1 (Triple Mentoring)

The concept of triple mentoring was introduced and the applications were discussed to be implemented as best practice for 2019-20. The idea was to introduce new pattern of mentoring in lines with mentor-mentee mode, and mentoring through peer groups. Vertical mentoring was the central idea to incorporate in mentoring system where third year students would mentor the first and second year students by lectures and doubt solving sessions. The activity is organized department-wise under the supervision of concerned subject teachers.

Agenda – 2 (Positive Psychology)

It was decided to categorize the "Positive Psychology" training material into three modules-Empathy, Sense of Purpose and Diversity and Acceptance. Content development for the modules was allocated to specific teams. They would further research and classify their allotted module into four distinct titles and also design it in such a manner that activity based learning is facilitated. The third lecture every Monday shall be fixed as Positive Psychology slots across all the courses and classes.

Agenda – 3 (sessions for advanced and slow learners)

As a part of improving educational standards, schedule for sessions for advance and slow learners should be made and followed. The sessions are organized department/class wise for each subjects.

Agenda – 4 (Management Information System)

For NAAC documentation, records of activities organized are of utmost importance. IQAC discussed on streamlining the present management information system to track activities and keep authentic records.

Agenda – 5 (Feedback)

Online feedbacks of different classes are to be collected by feedback committee before the end of semester. For smooth conduction, time slots should be given for each class. The students should be accompanied by faculty-in-charge to guide them through the process.

Agenda – 6 (Research related activities)

As a part of research activities, faculty members were encouraged to present papers in MES research forums organized on 27th September, 2019 by Pillai Group of Institutions. IQAC also discussed on encouraging faculty members to submit Minor research projects for research grants from University of Mumbai. Discussions were held on planning of National Conference of Science by IQAC in association with Department of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics to be organized at the start of even semester.

Action Taken Report

- Introduced Vertical Mentoring System across all departments where TY students engaged FY and SY classes to assist learning process and encourage interactive sessions
- Distribution of modules and setting of Time tables for activity based positive psychology sessions
- Course co-ordinators scheduled subject wise timetable for each class for sessions by respective subject faculty members to assist slow learners and enhance the advanced learners. The sessions were planned on dates adhering to examinations.
- A new committee was organized as a part of management information system to keep a systematic record of all activities organized, curricular, co-curricular or extracurricular in the college on 16 August, 2019. Ms. Babita Kurup was nominated as convener for same along with a team of faculty members to provide authentic data for documentation. The committee is formed for assistance to compile data for AQAR to be submitted every year.
- Feedback Committee prepared a schedule with time allotments for each class to submit online feedback under the guidance of Class Coordinators on 26-27 September, 2019
- Prof. Priyesh Keekan represented the college in MES Research Forum and presented paper on 'Hoping for an early dawn: The plight of tribal women in India', organised on 27 September, 2019
- A total of eleven Minor Research Projects were submitted to University of Mumbai on 30 September, 2019
