1. Inter-Collegiate Film-Making Talks Webinar

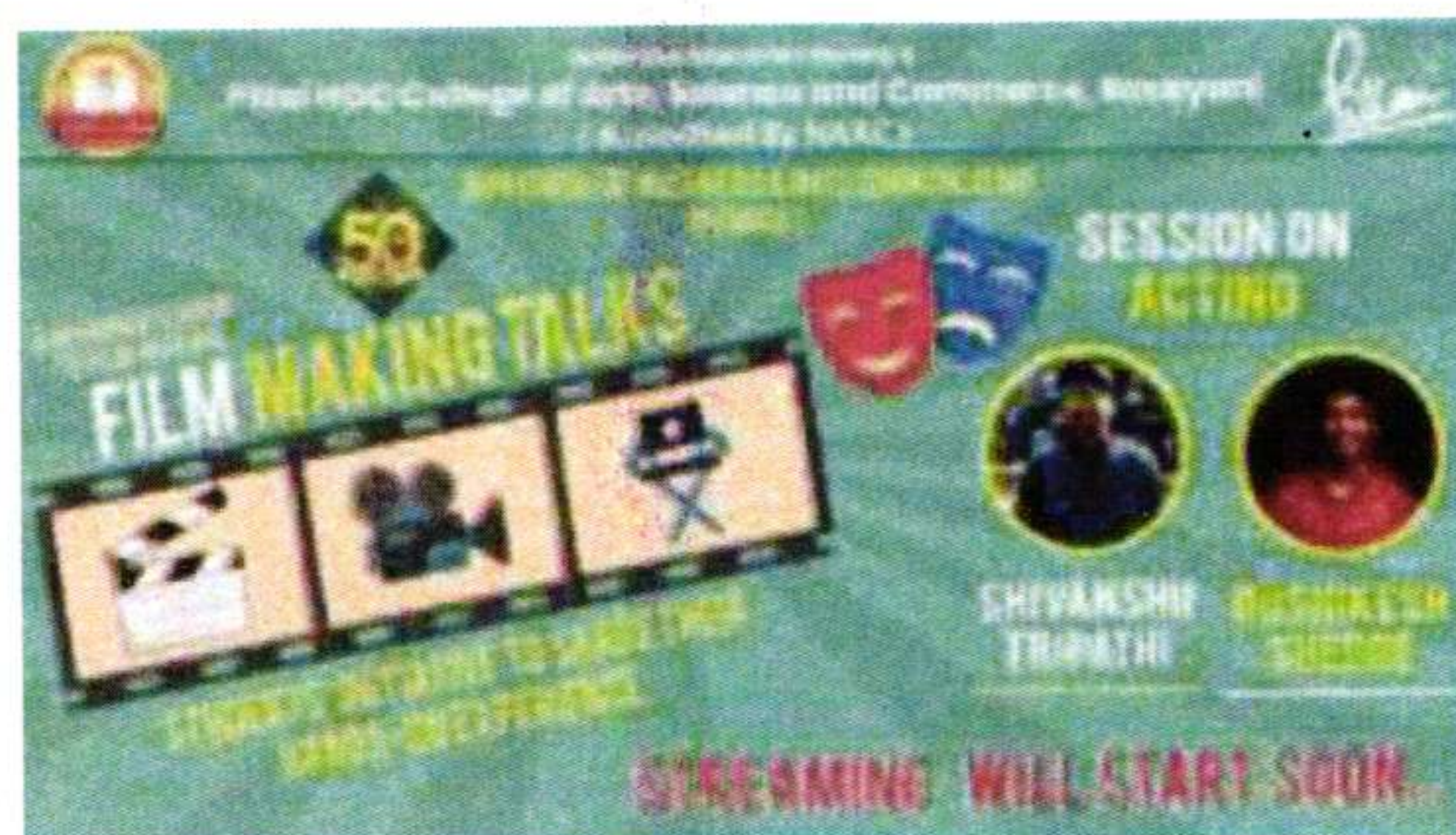
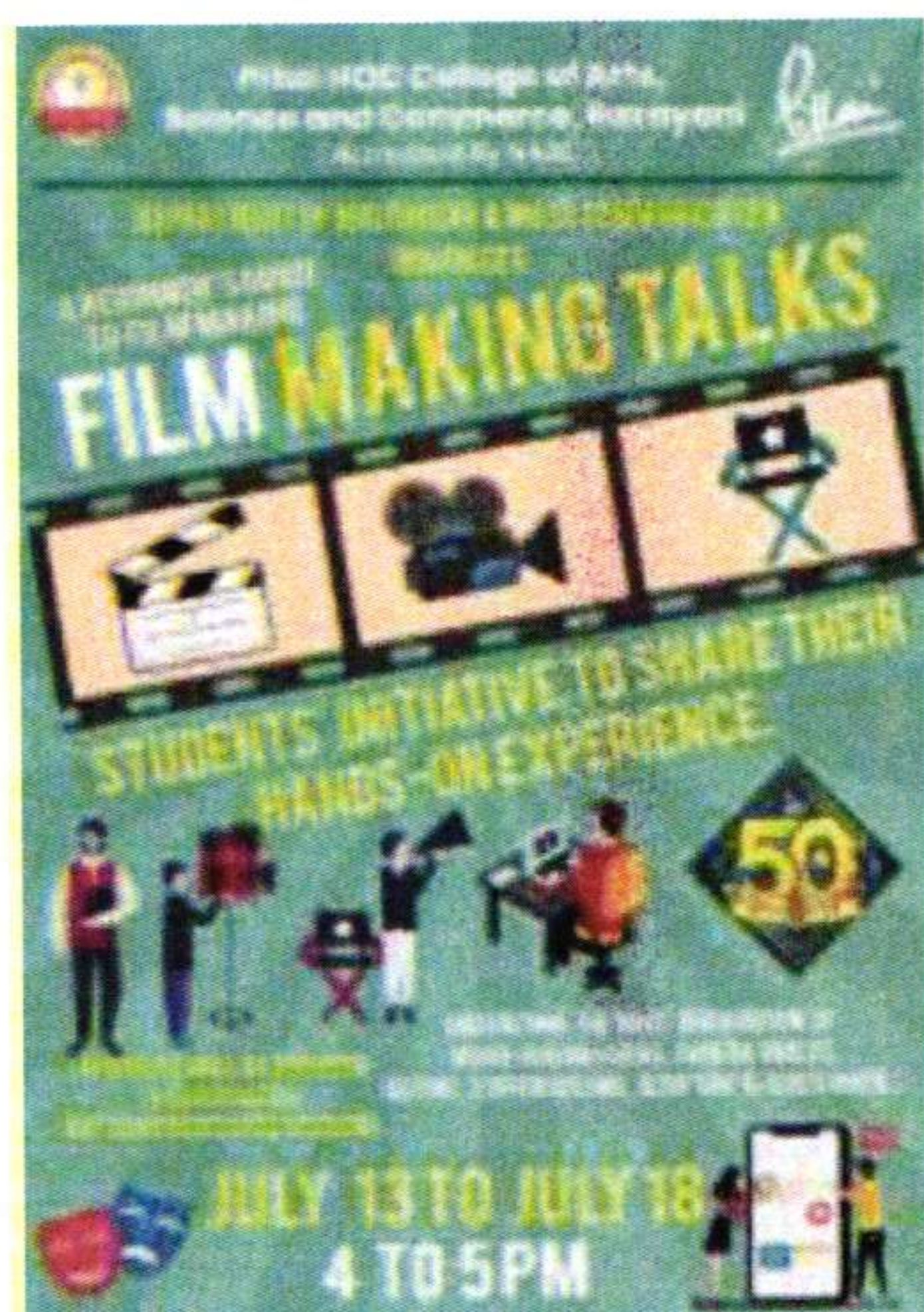

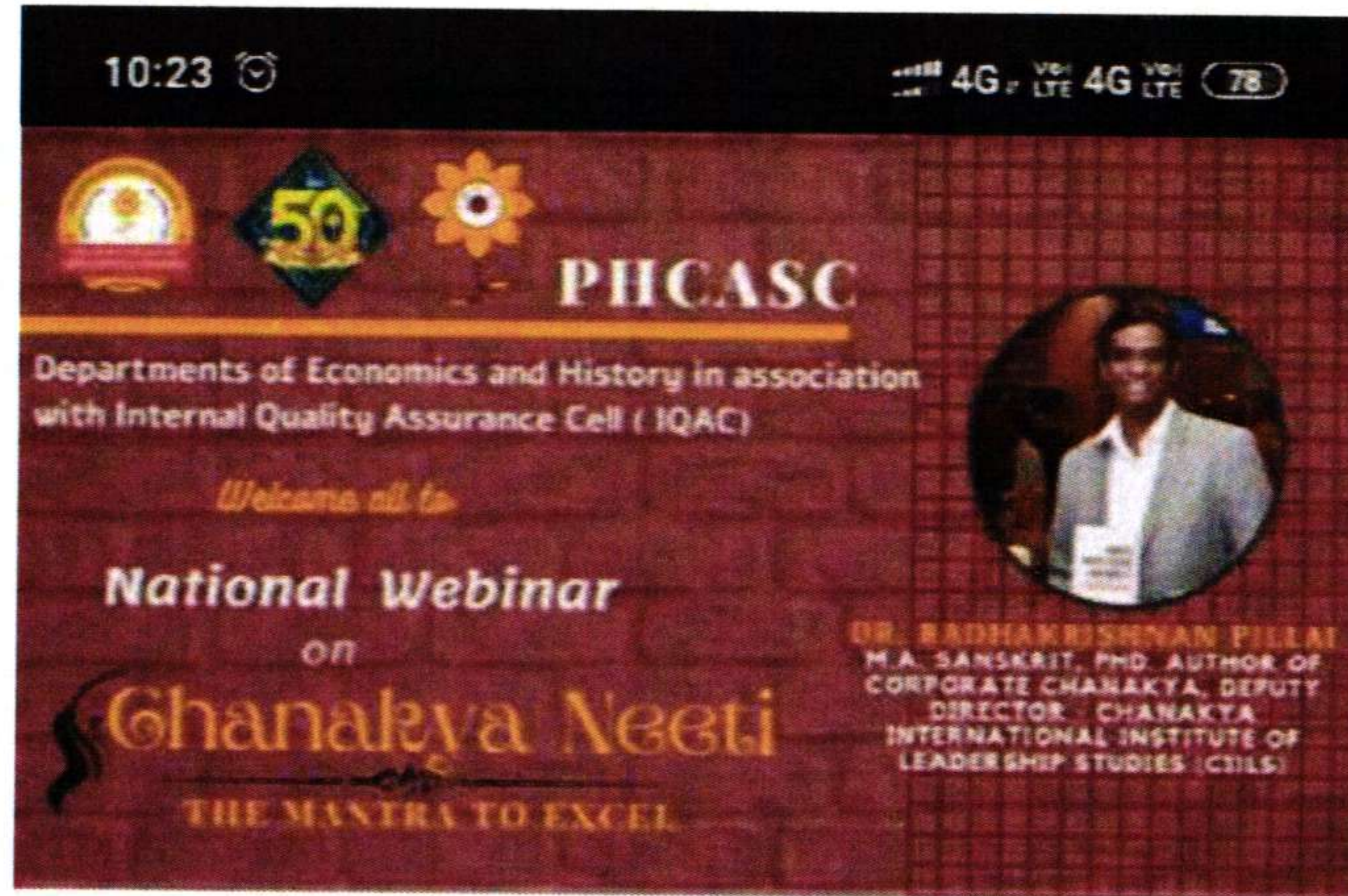
Around 100 participants were benefited with this programme which ended with proactive interactions from students and Vote of Thanks given by Prof. Prathamesh Gokhale.

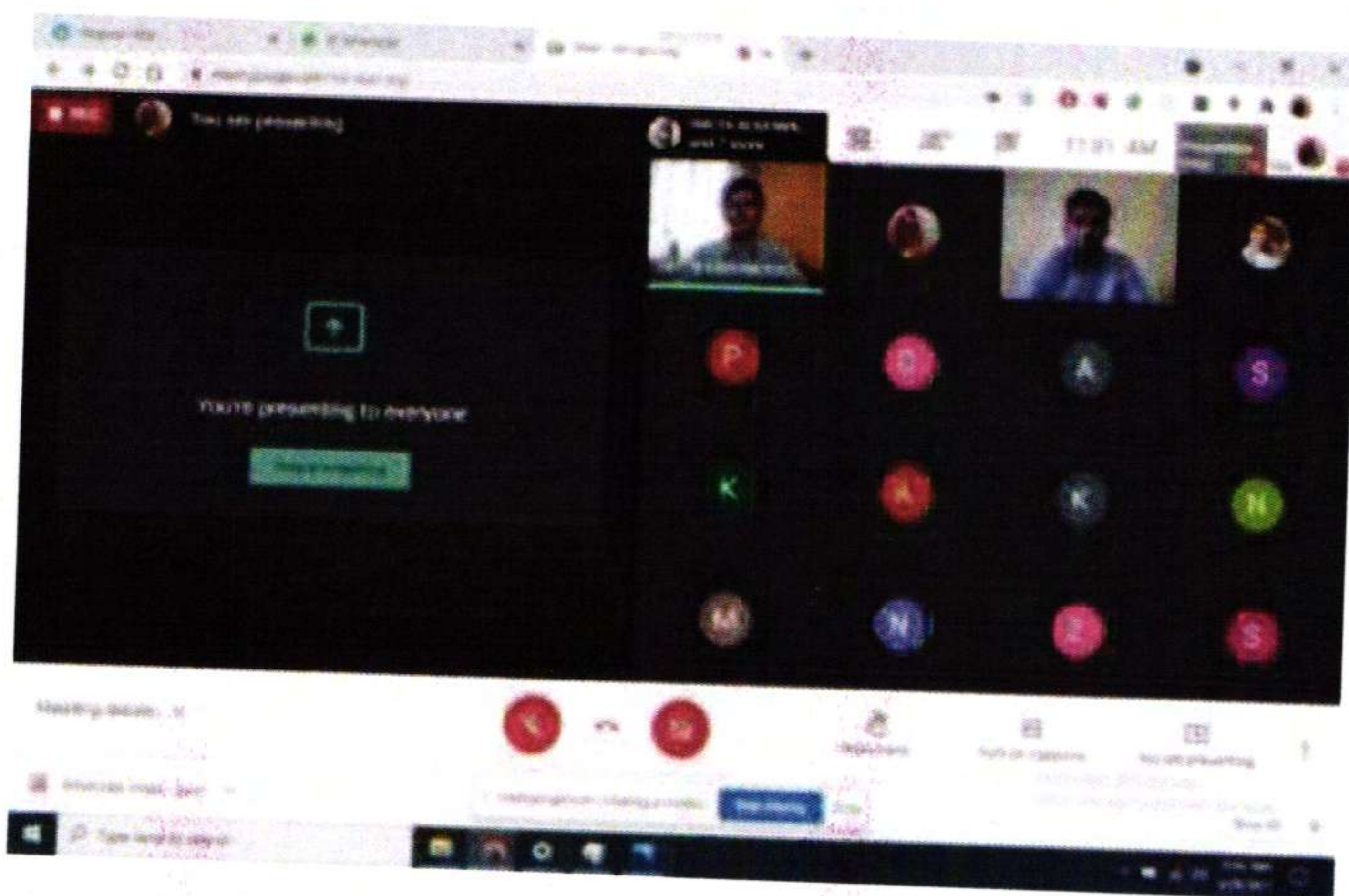
1. Alumni Guidance Session

2. A Webinar on Public Speaking Skills-How to Impress your Audience.

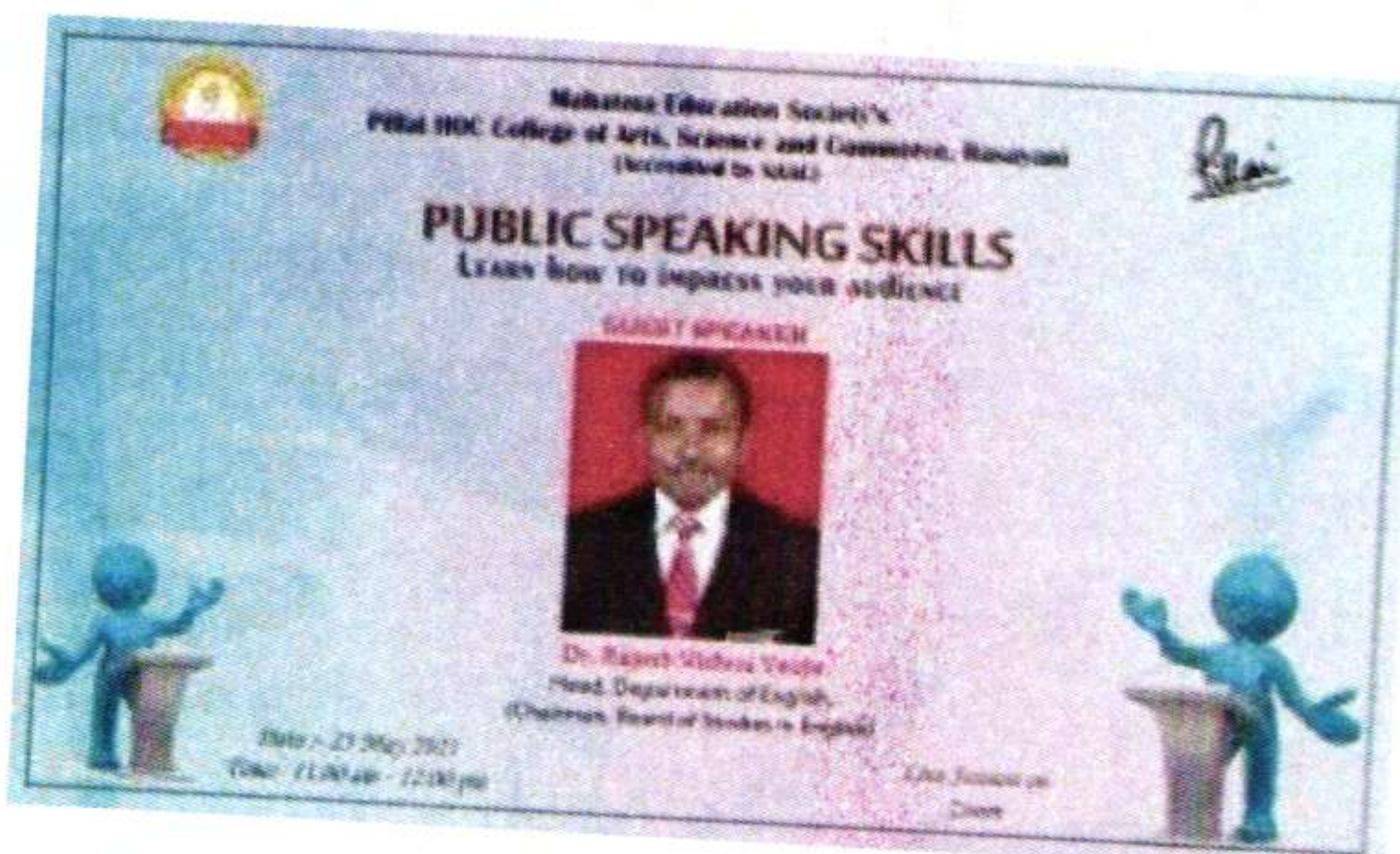
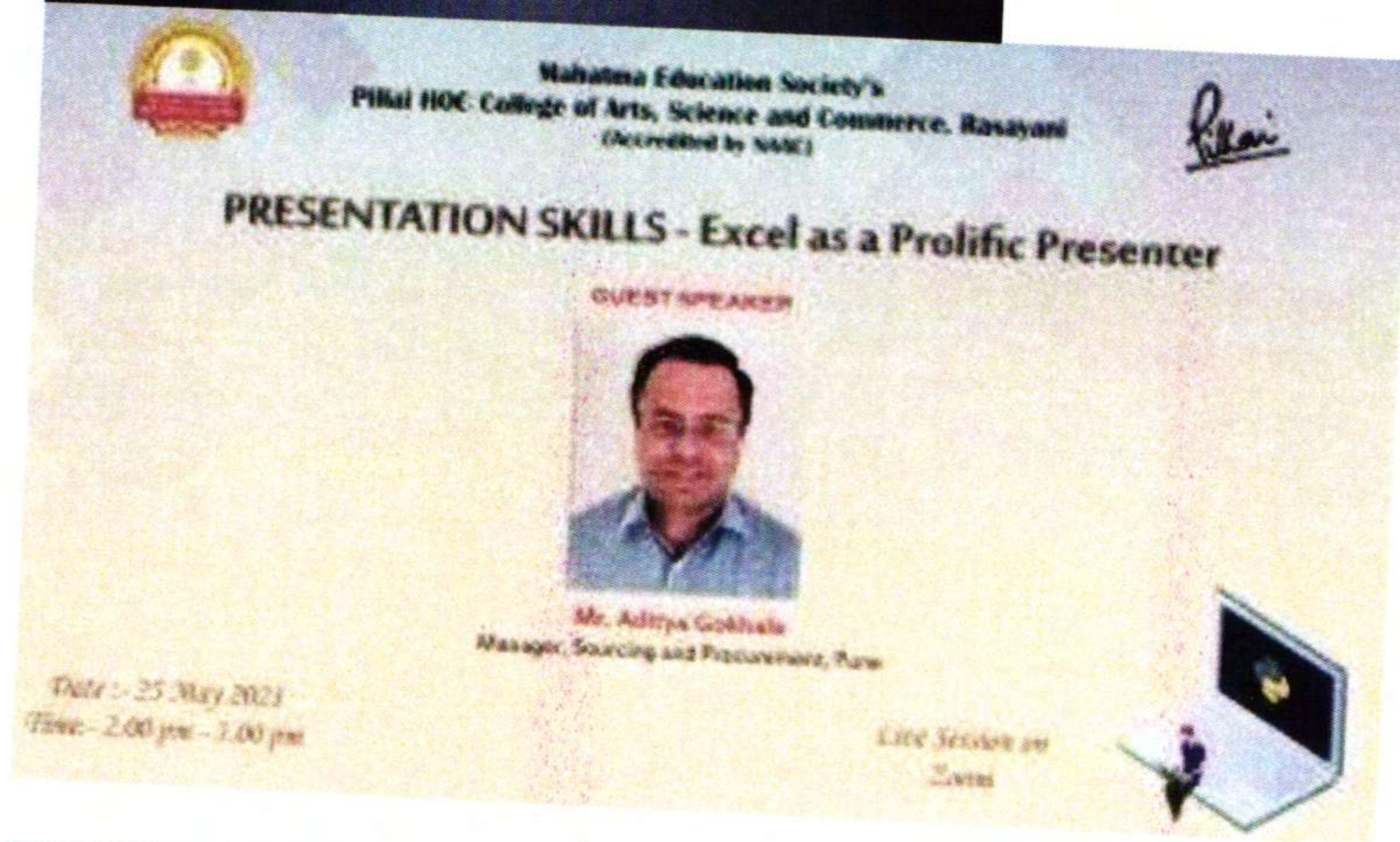
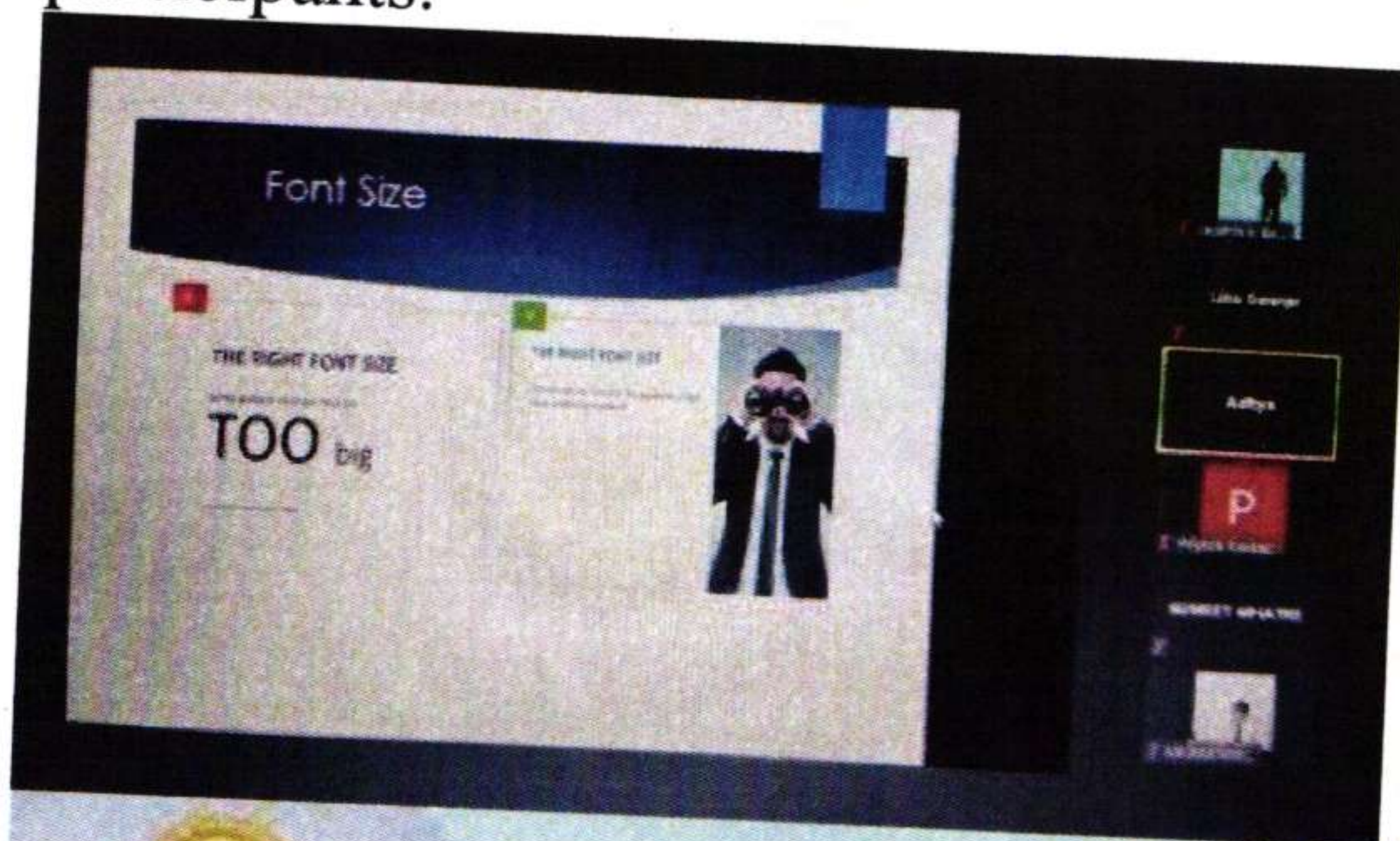

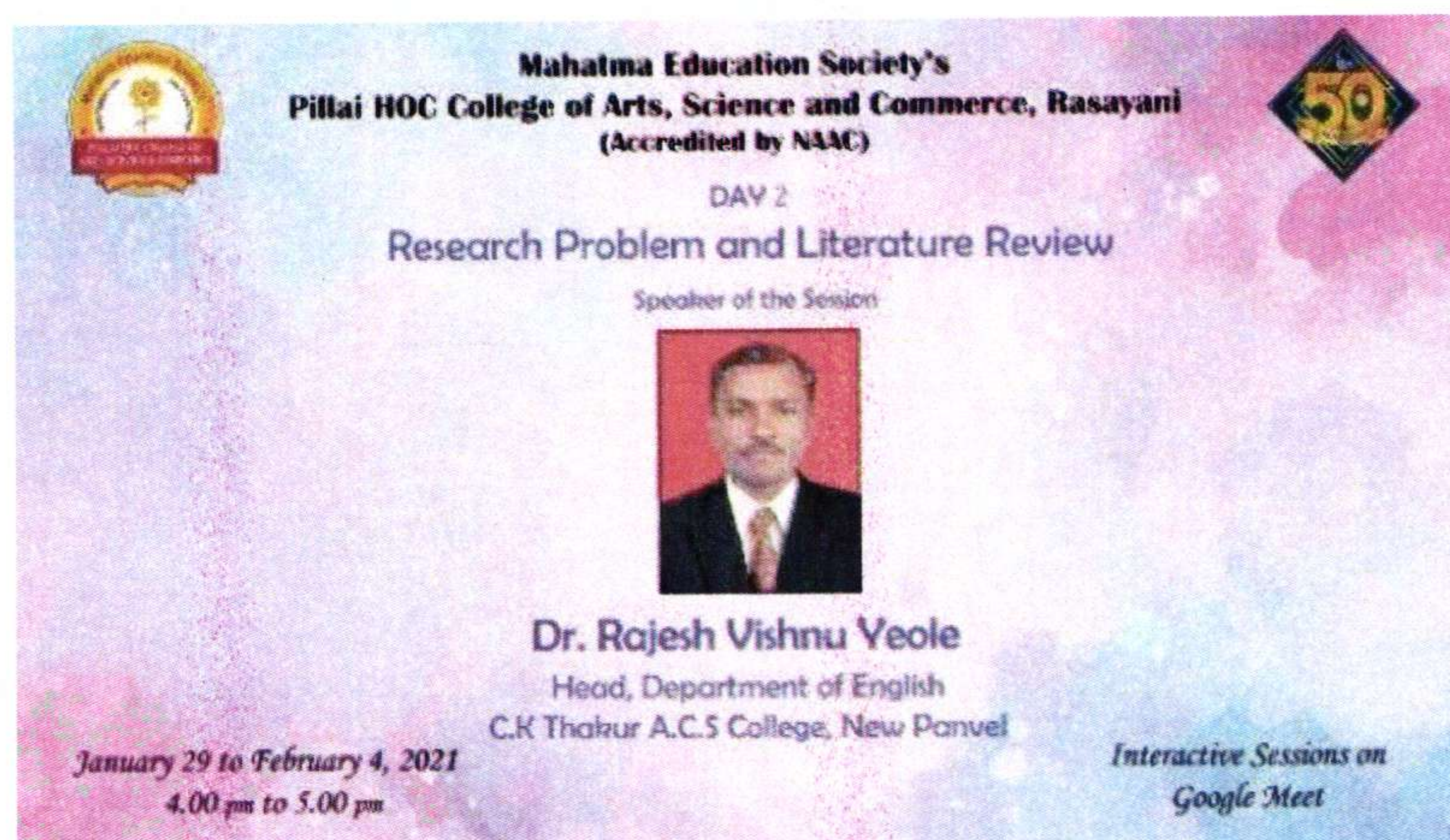
6. Faculty Development Programme – Six Days Seminar on Introduction to Research Methodology

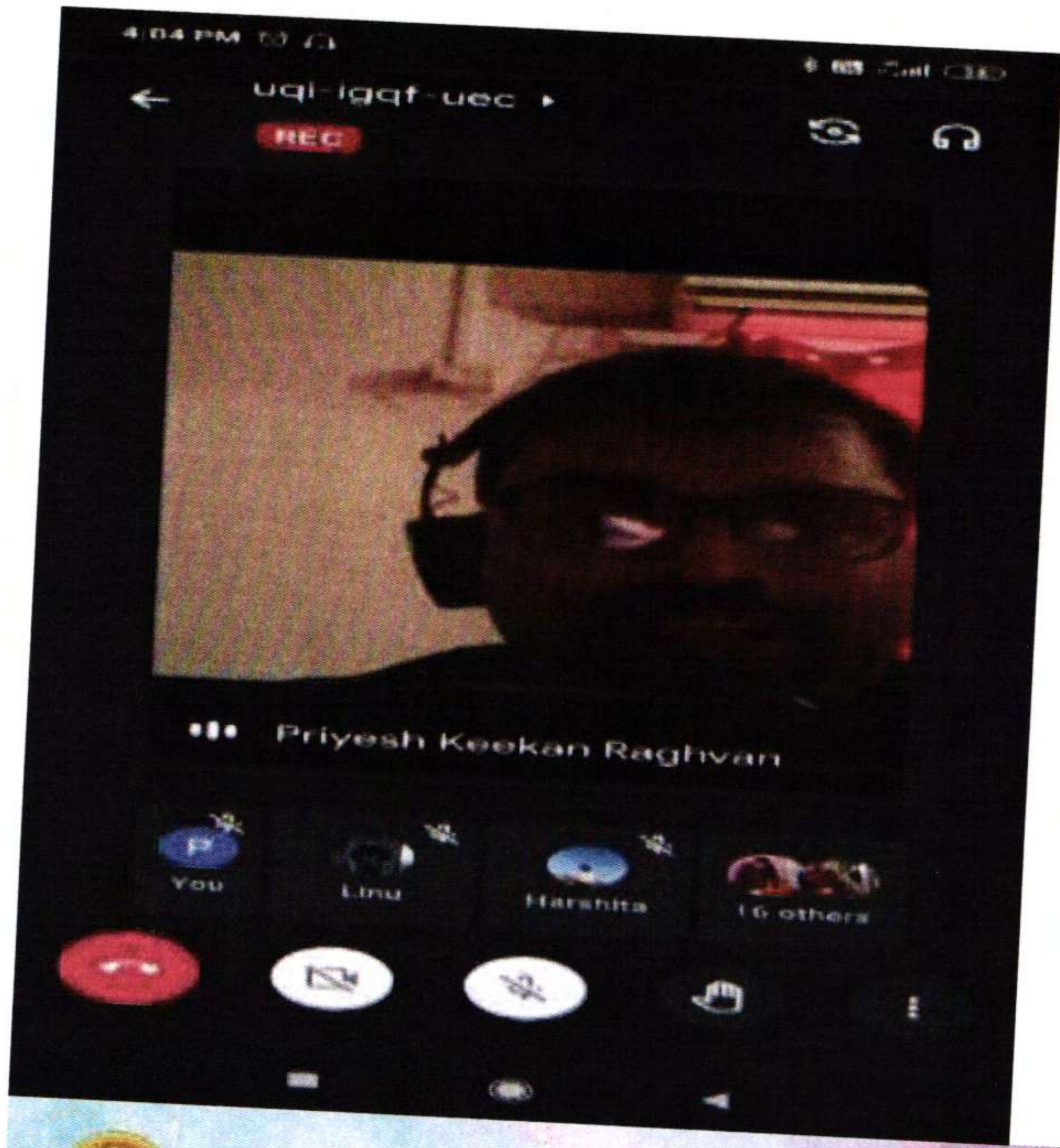
The in association with Internal Quality Assurance Cell organized One Week Faculty Development Programme on "Research Methodology" from January 29 to February 05,



Webinar on 'Fund Raising for Stat-up'

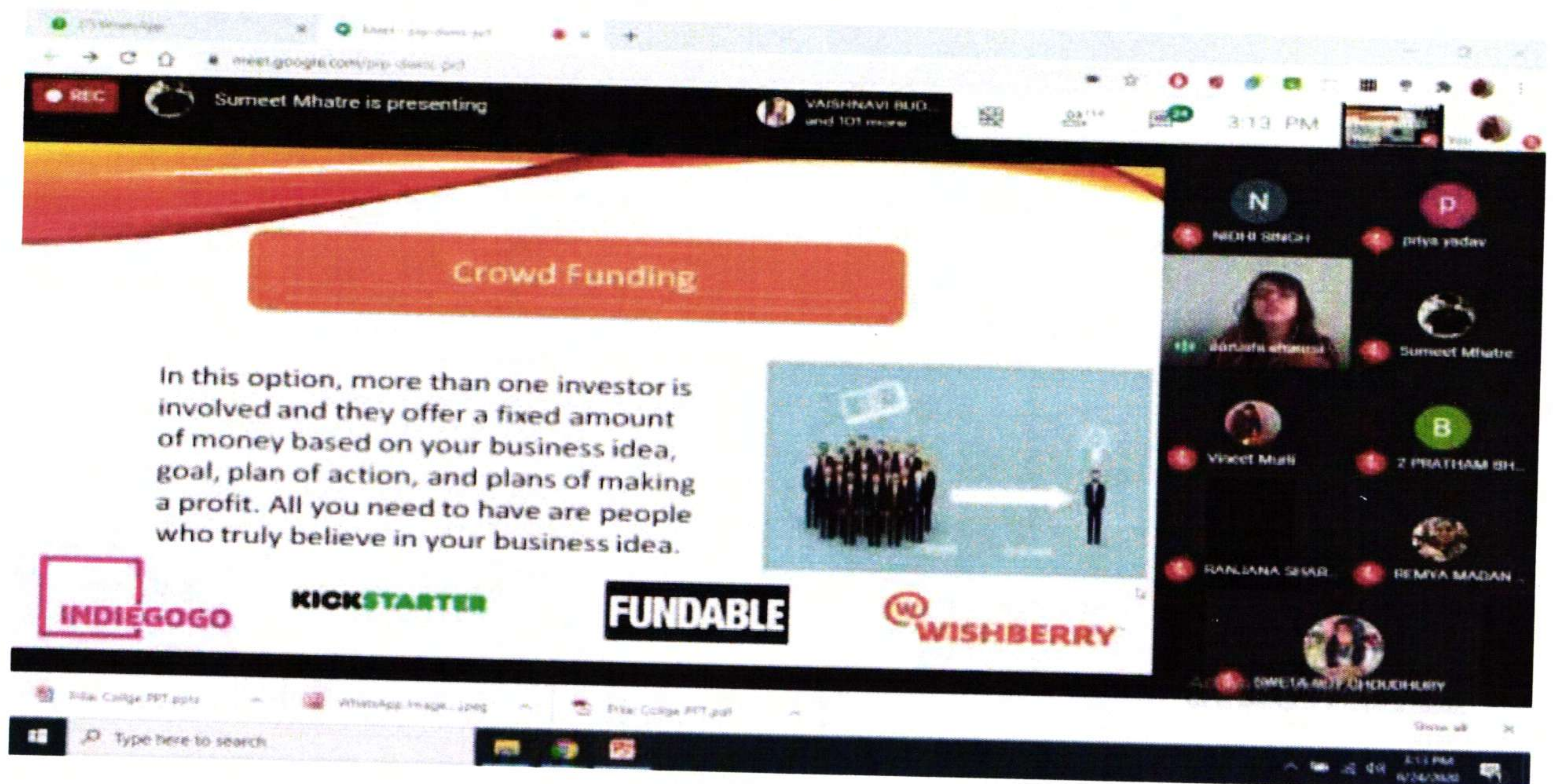

All attendees were very active in question and answer session and expressed their positive feedbacks, which truly has been inspirational for us.

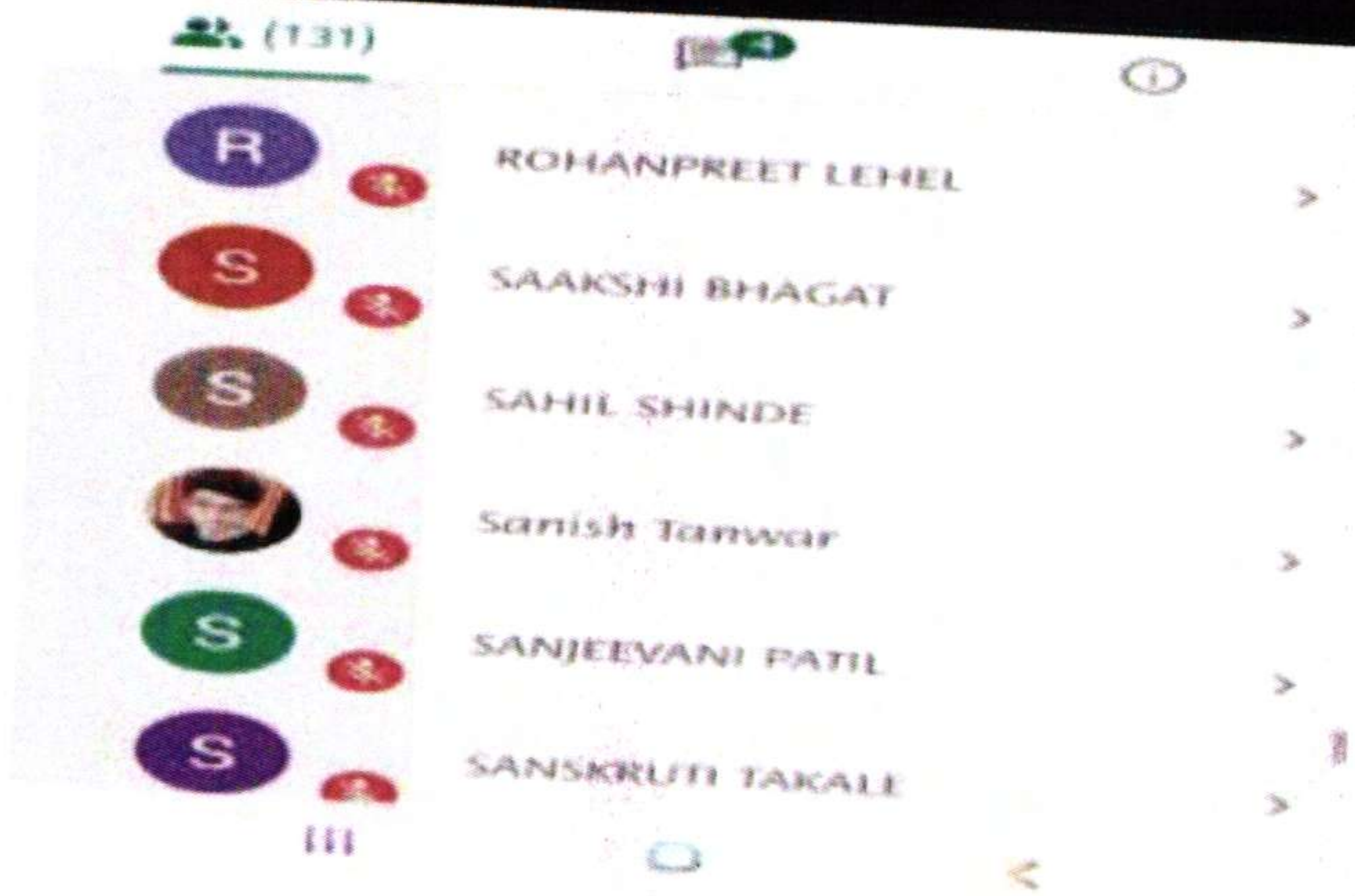
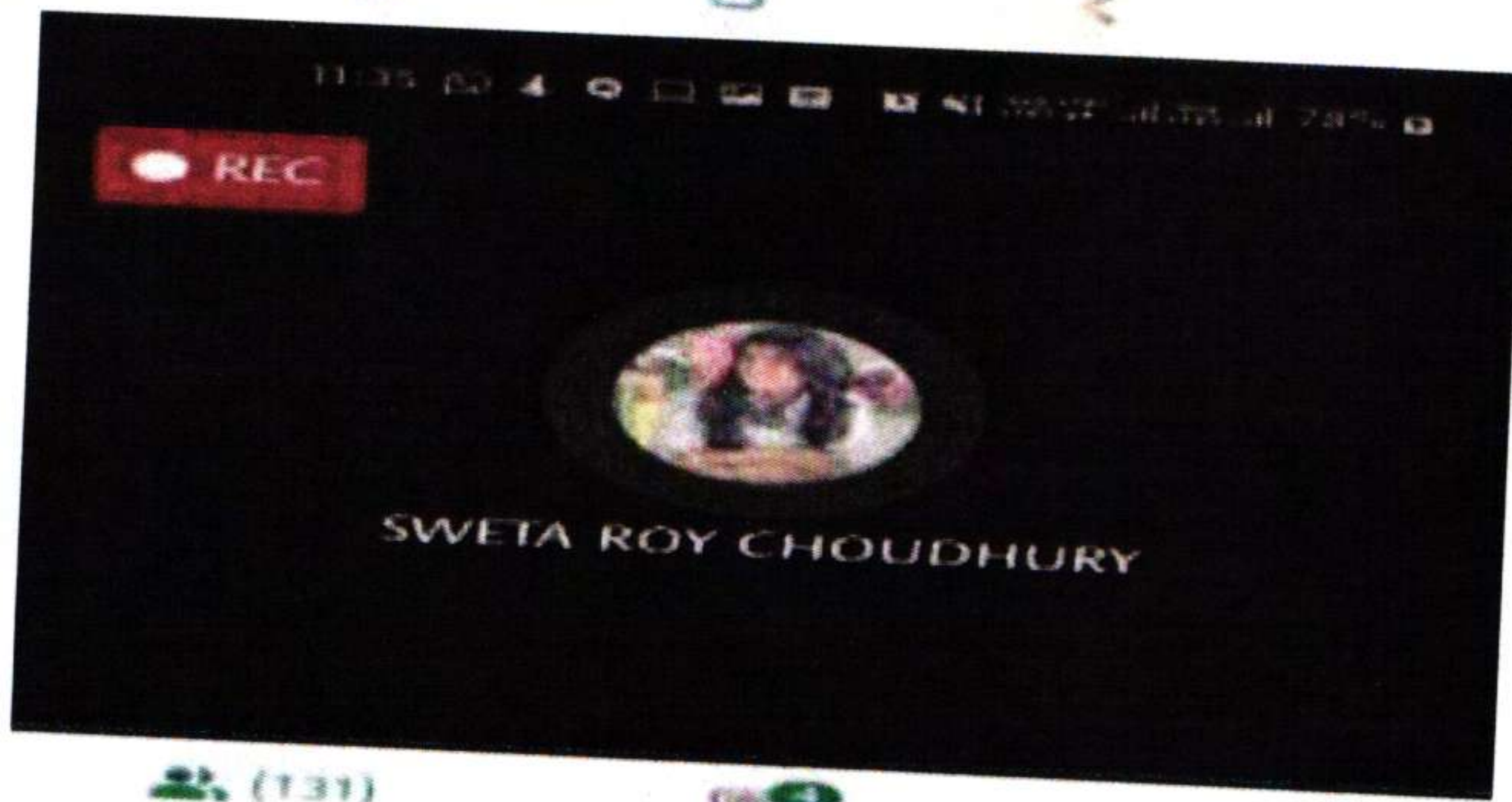
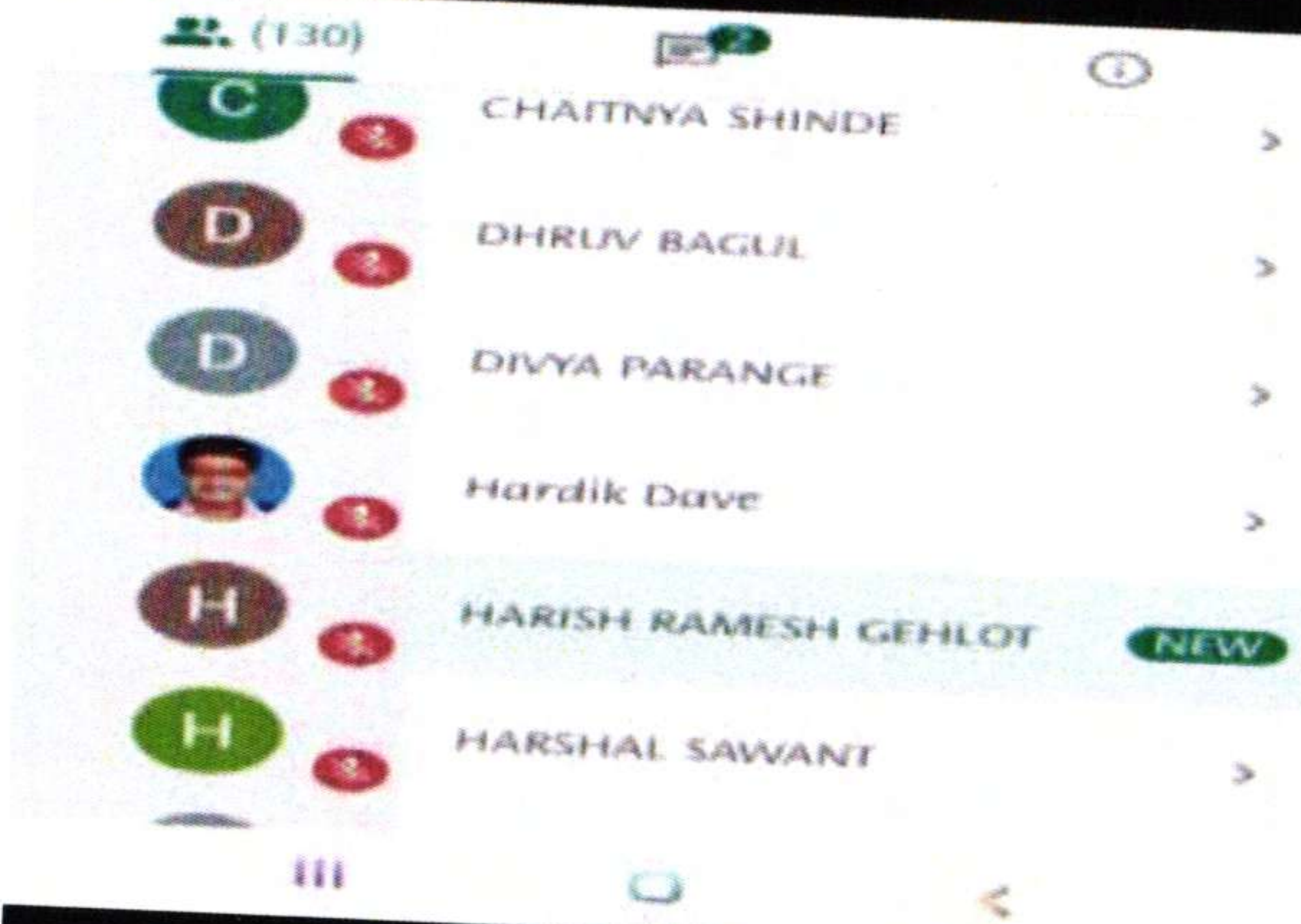
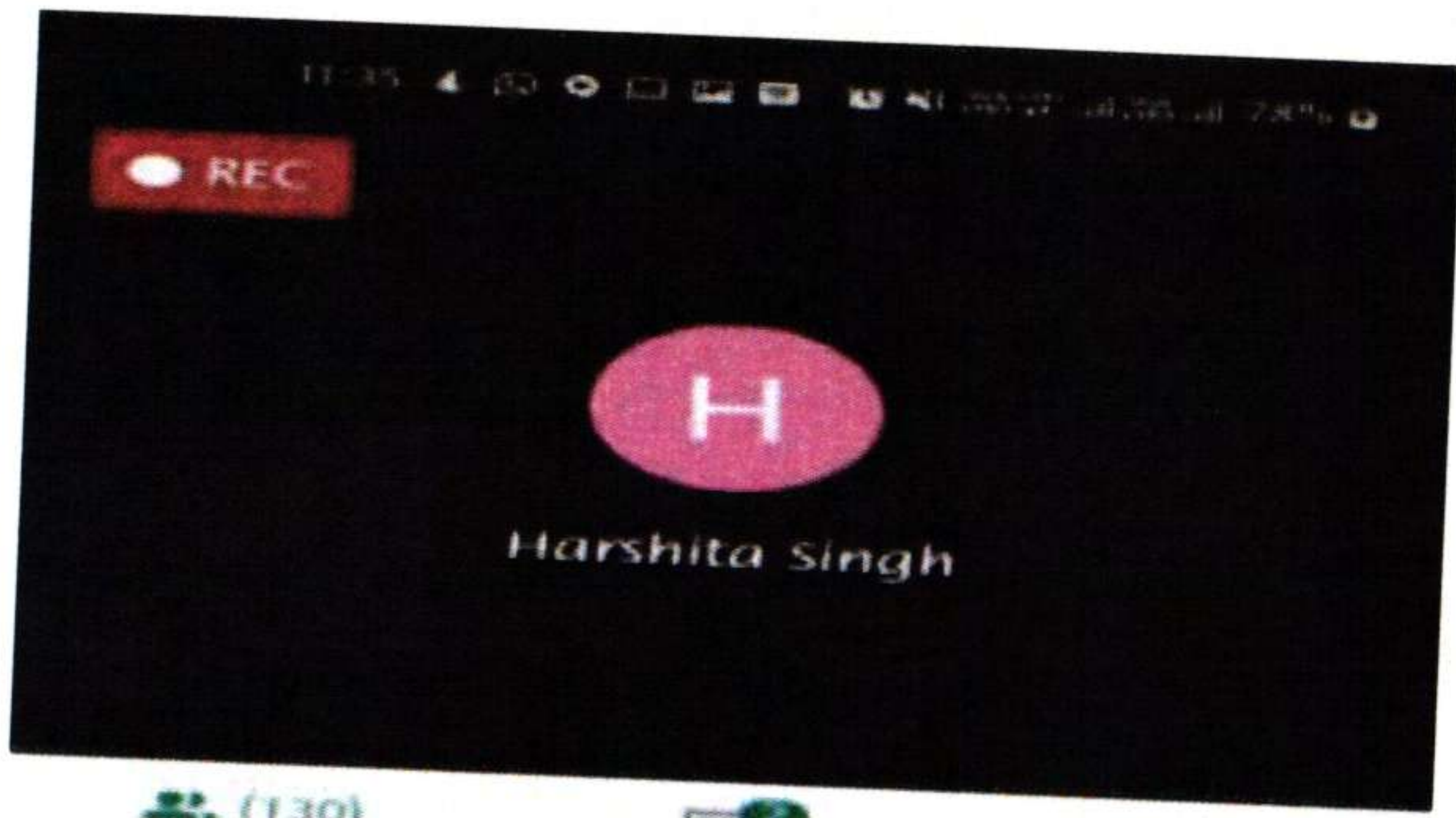



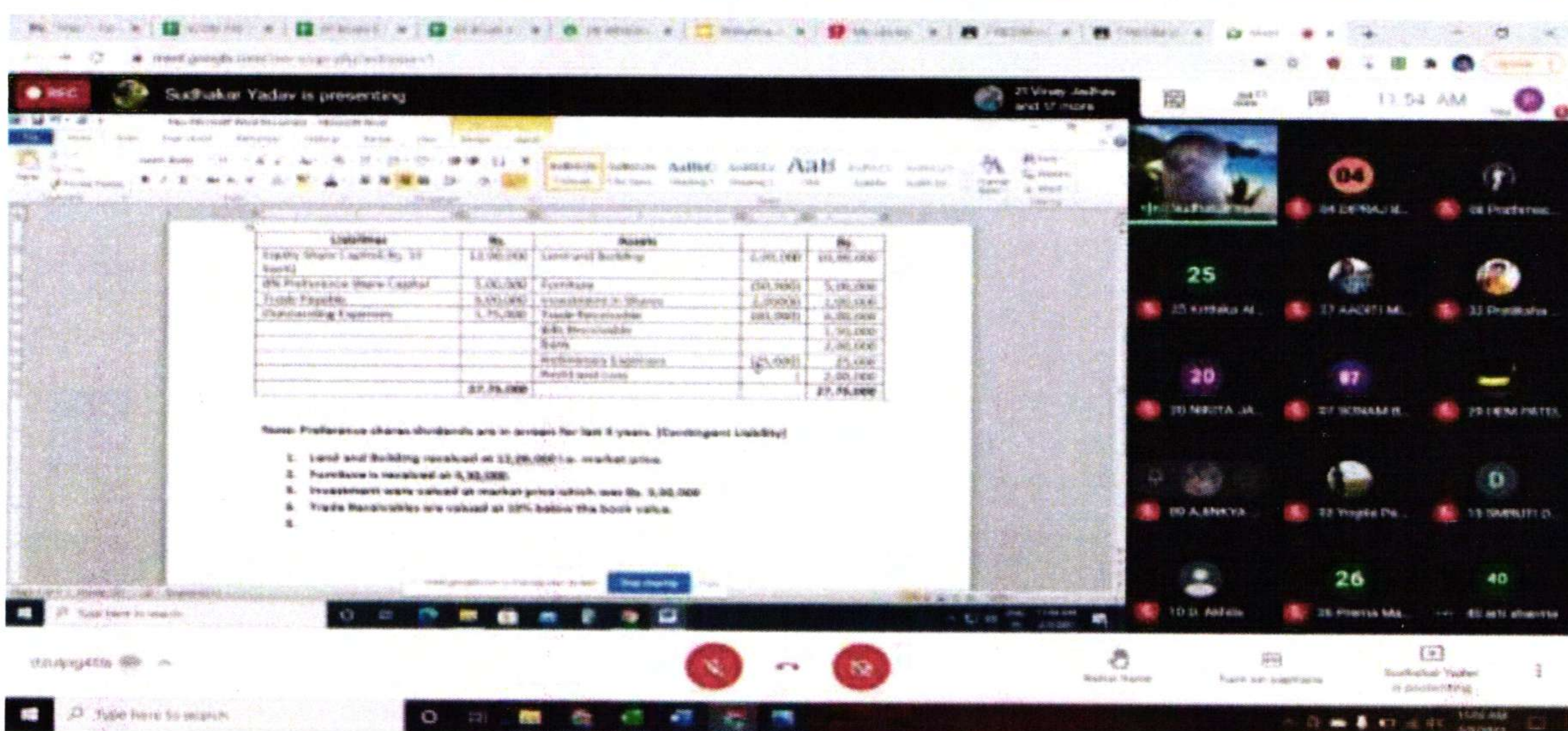
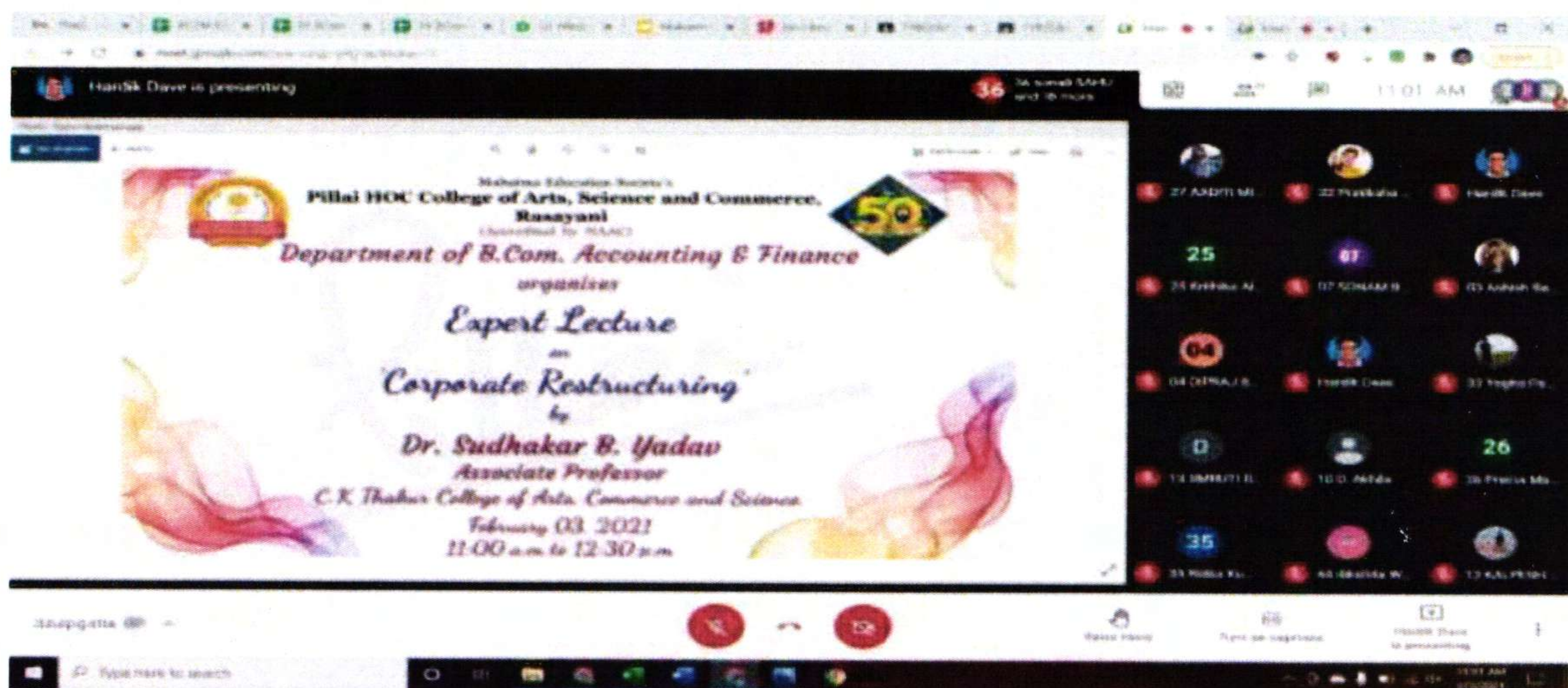


Expert Lecture on 'Corporate Restructuring'



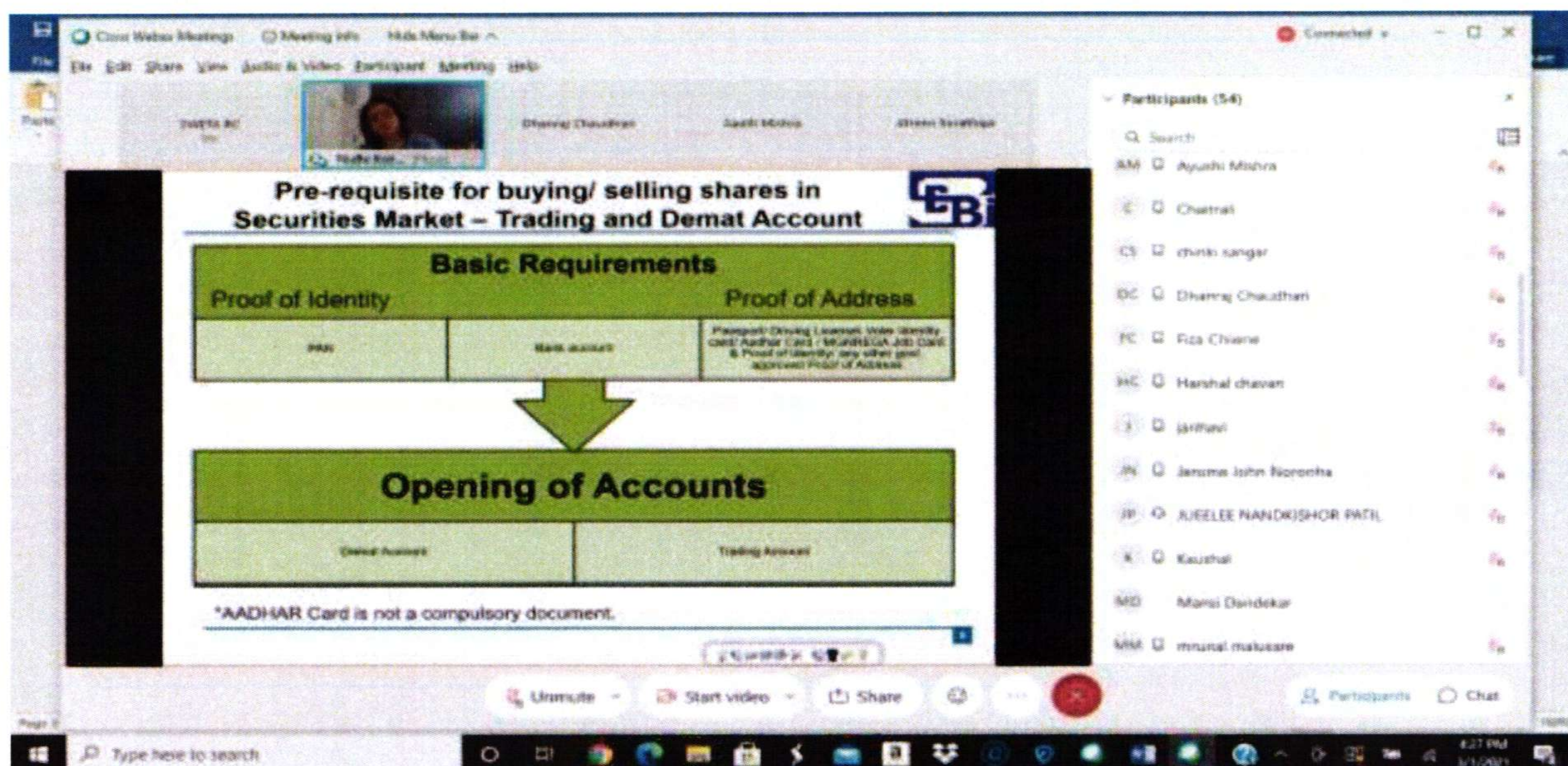

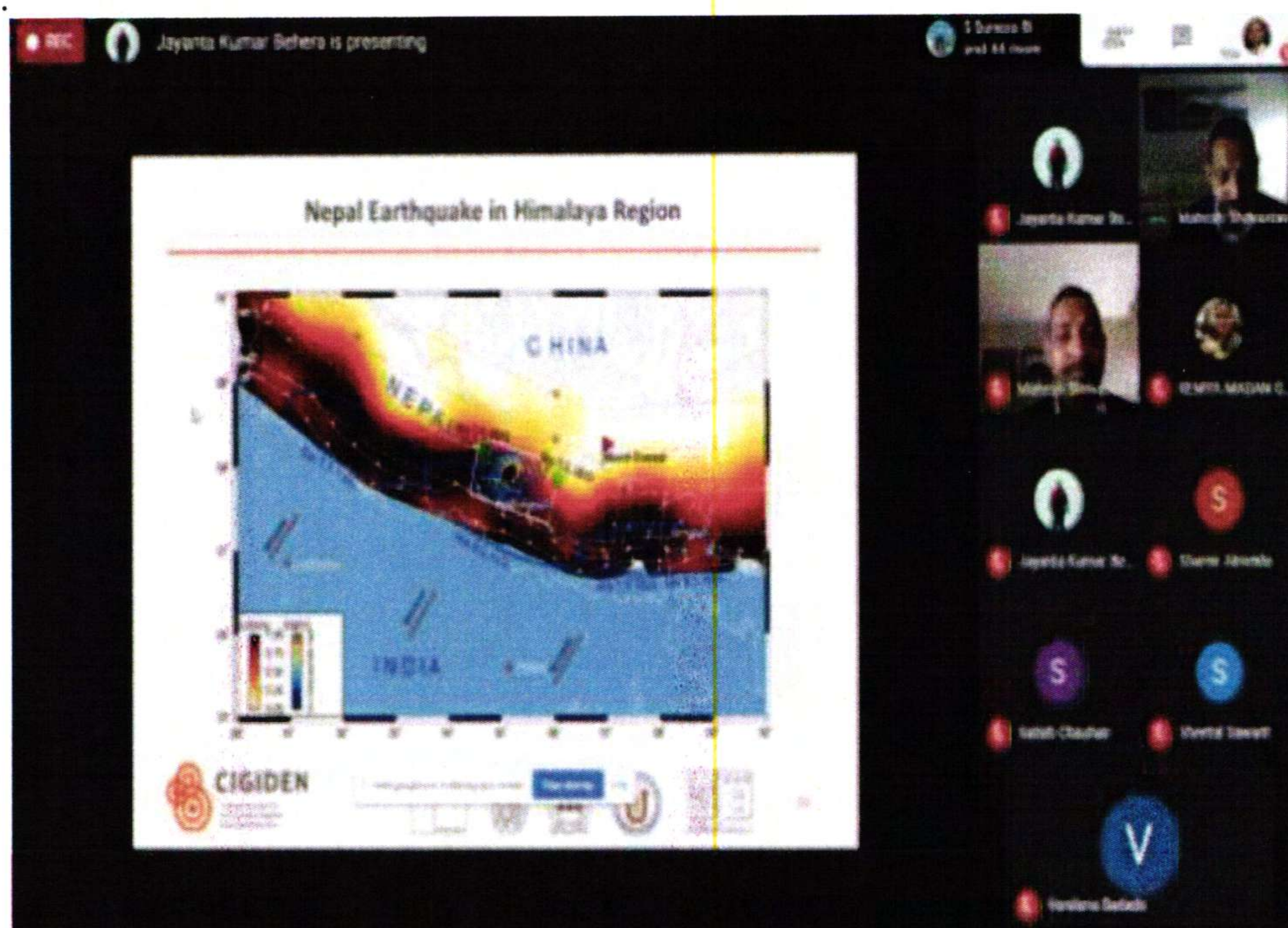
International Webinar was titled "Seismic Hazards Assessment: Predictions and Challenges for a Safe Environment"

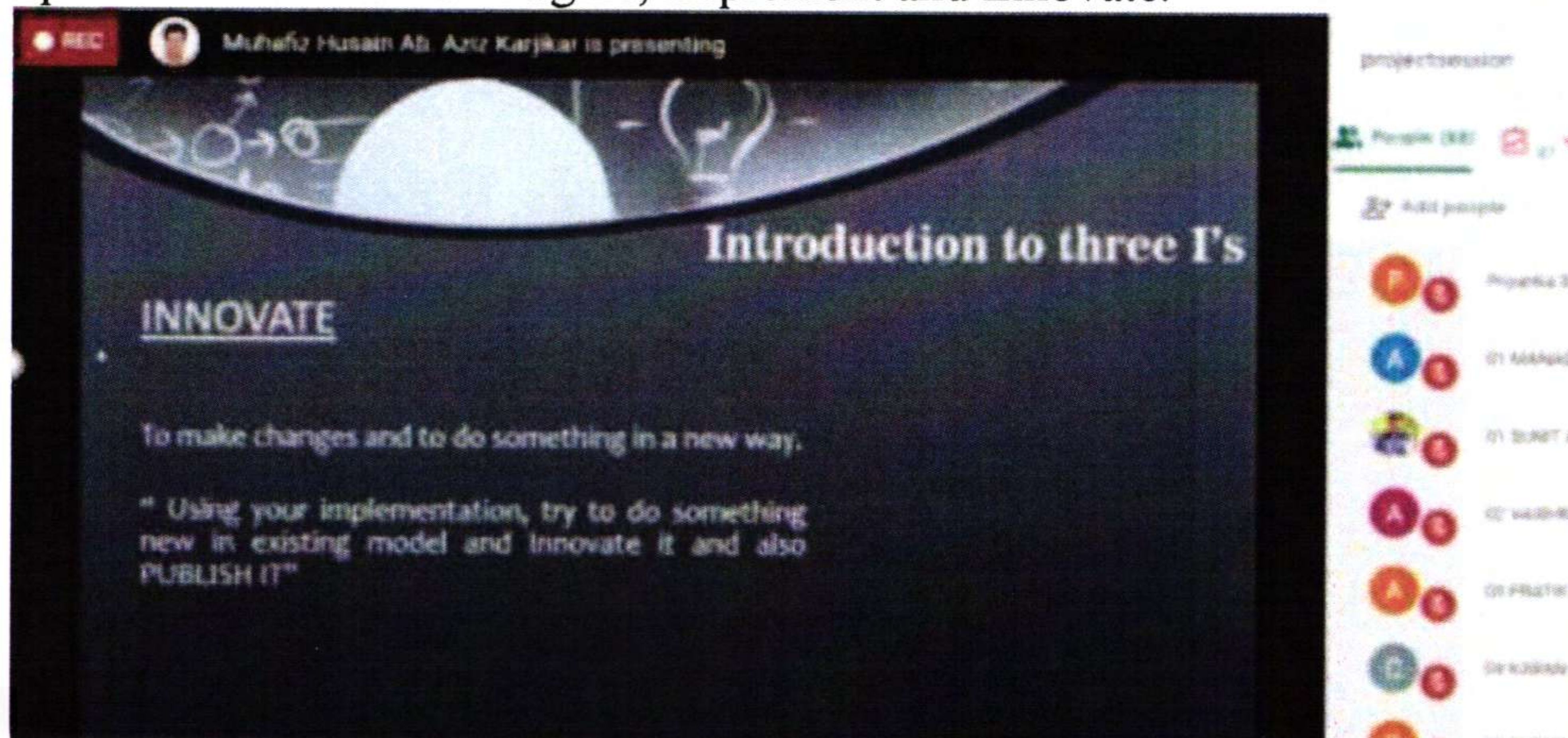
Guidance Lecture for Final Year Project Development

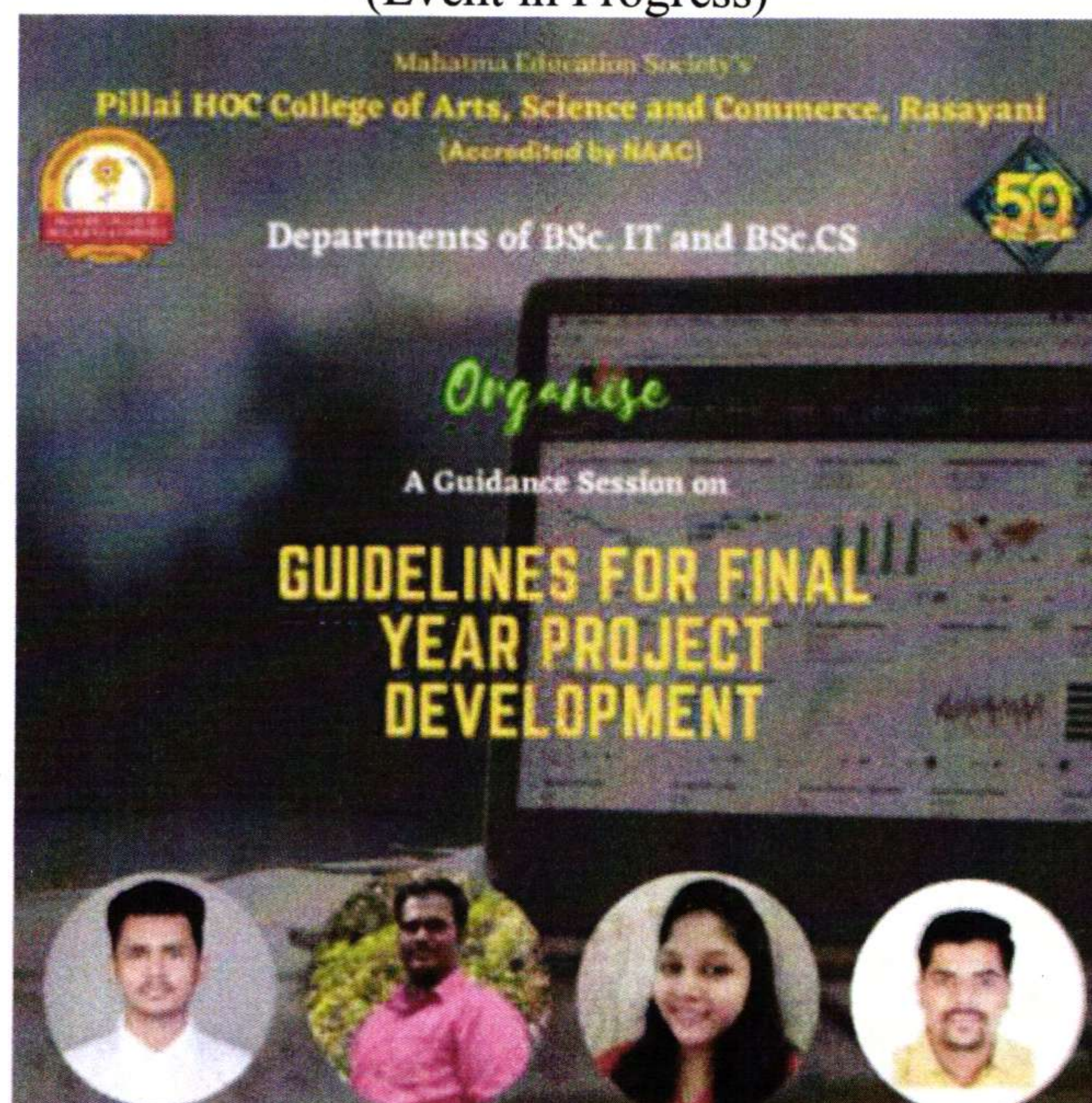

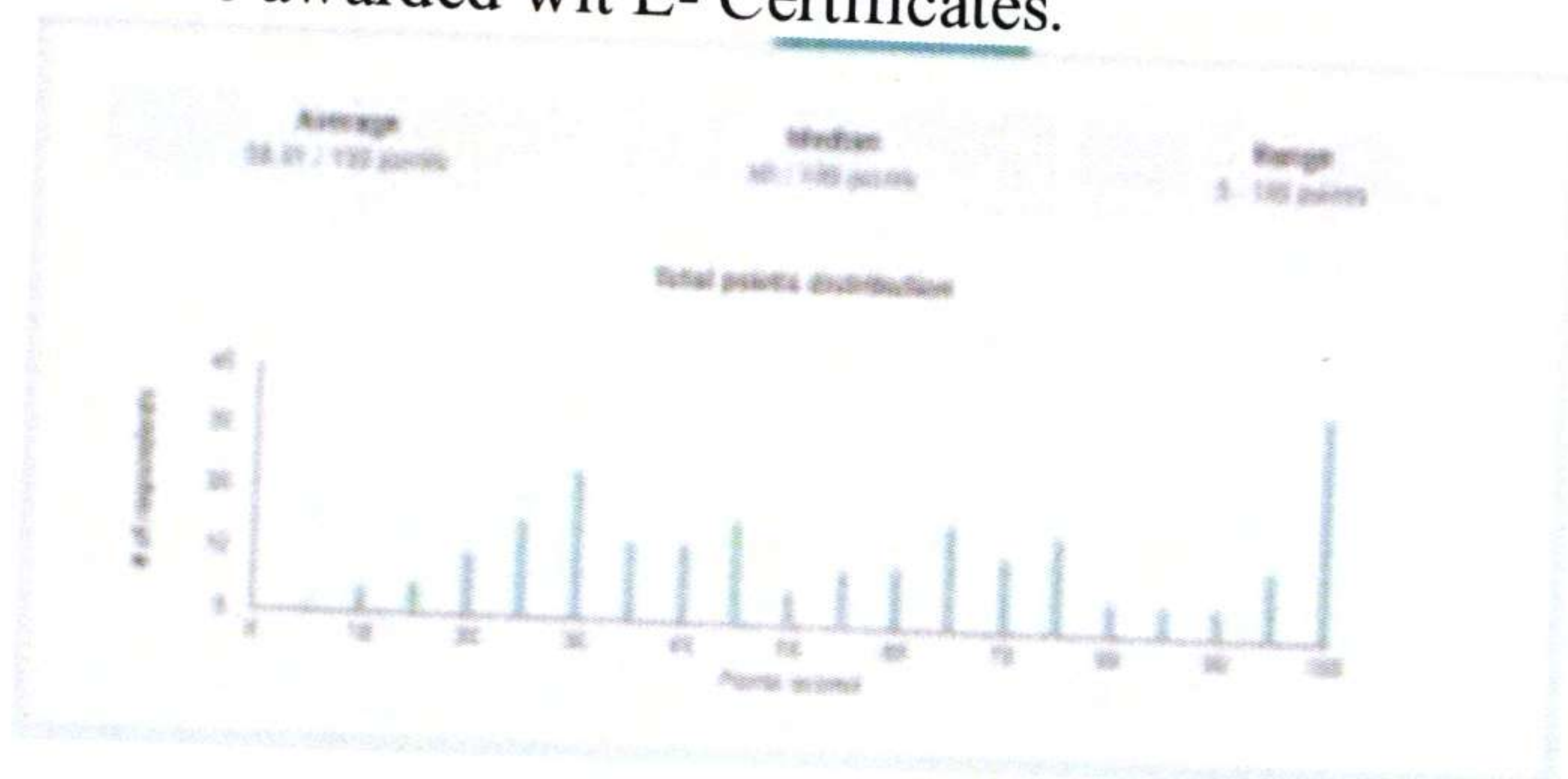

There was an overwhelming response of 237 participants from various colleges in Mumbai. Over 164 participants were awarded with E- Certificates.

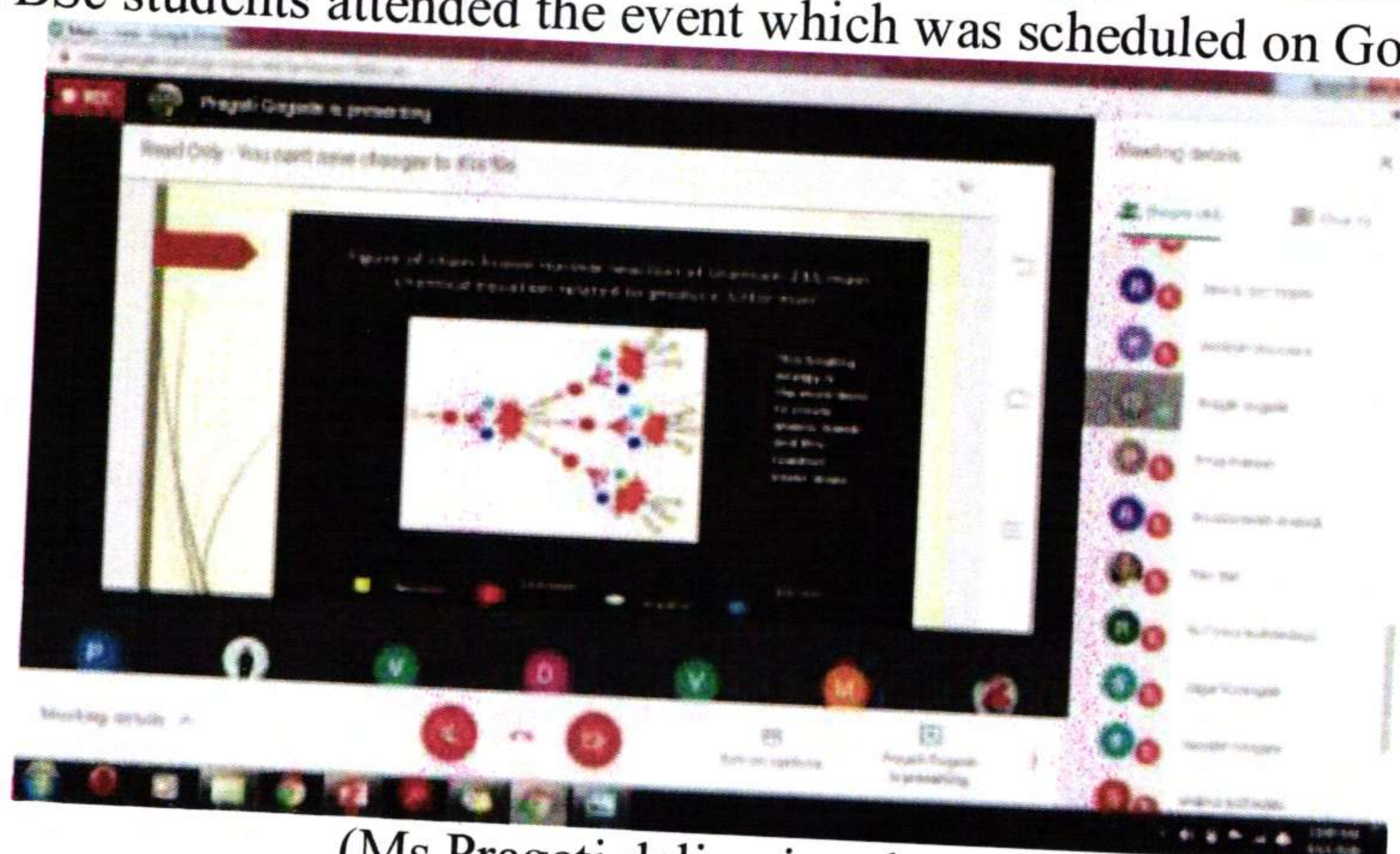

Celebrating Fibonacci Day is best done by studying and researching the Fibonacci sequence, and going out in nature and finding where it exists, which is everywhere. Fibonacci Sequence In Nature

The Fibonacci sequence is one of the most famous formulas in mathematics. Each number of in the sequence is the sum of two numbers that precede it. So the sequece goes: 0, 1, 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, 13, 21, 34 and so on.

The mathematical ^{equation} describing it is $X_{n+2} = X_{n+1} + X_n$

Another simple example in which it is possible to find the Fibonacci sequence in nature, is given by the number of petals of flowers. Most have three (like lilies & irises), five (pansy, rosehips) or eight (cosmos), 13, 21, 34, 55 or 89.



The pattern of seeds within a Sunflower follows the fibonacci sequence.



The sunflower seed pattern used by the national Museum of Mathematics contains many spiral.

Fibonacci also laid the groundwork for our modern-day mathematical understanding of certain shapes in nature, including Nautilus shells.



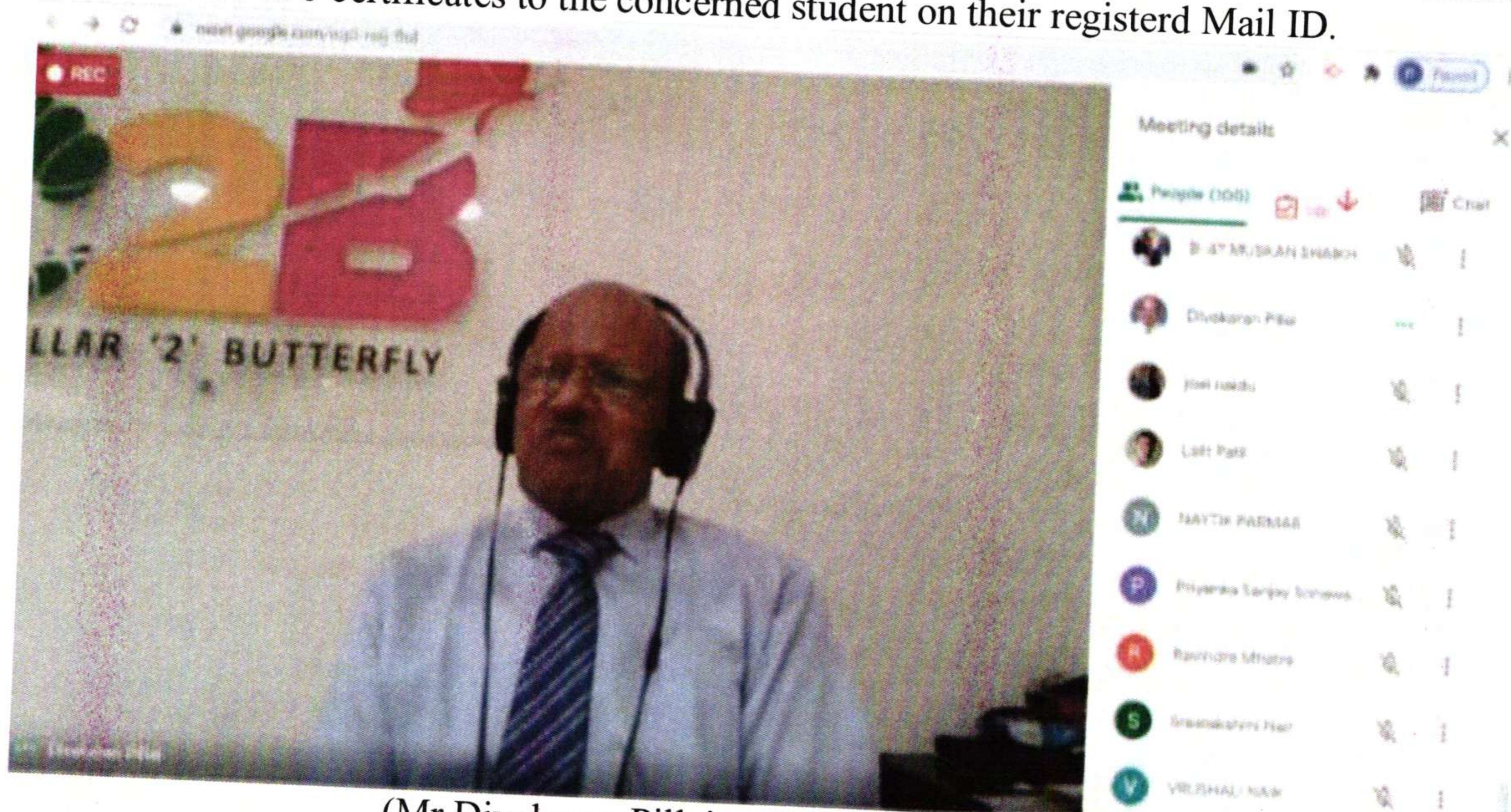
Spiders weave structures together making sheets, tangling, and funnel webs. The Fibonacci sequence allows for the web to be strengthened and also remain compact. Nature uses the Fibonacci sequence to accommodate growth and the length of the potential web.

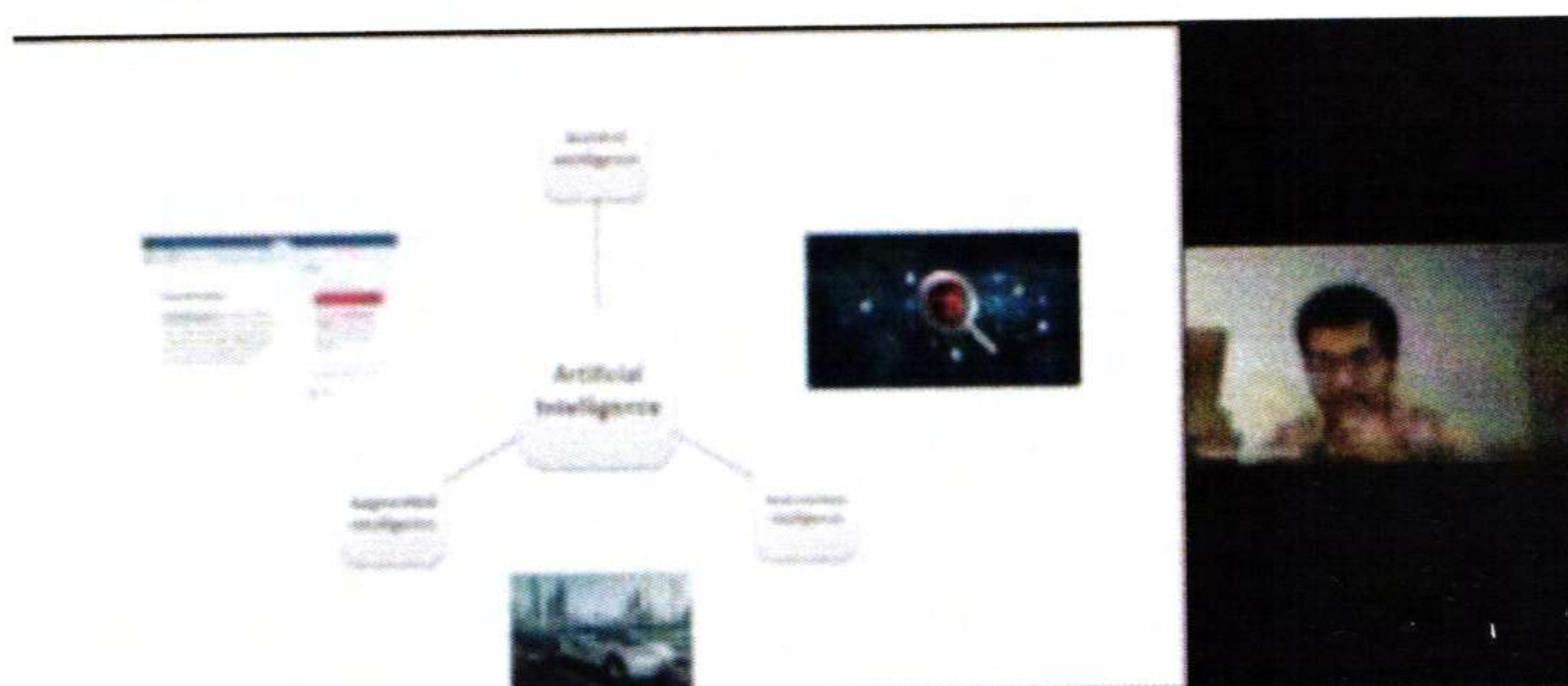

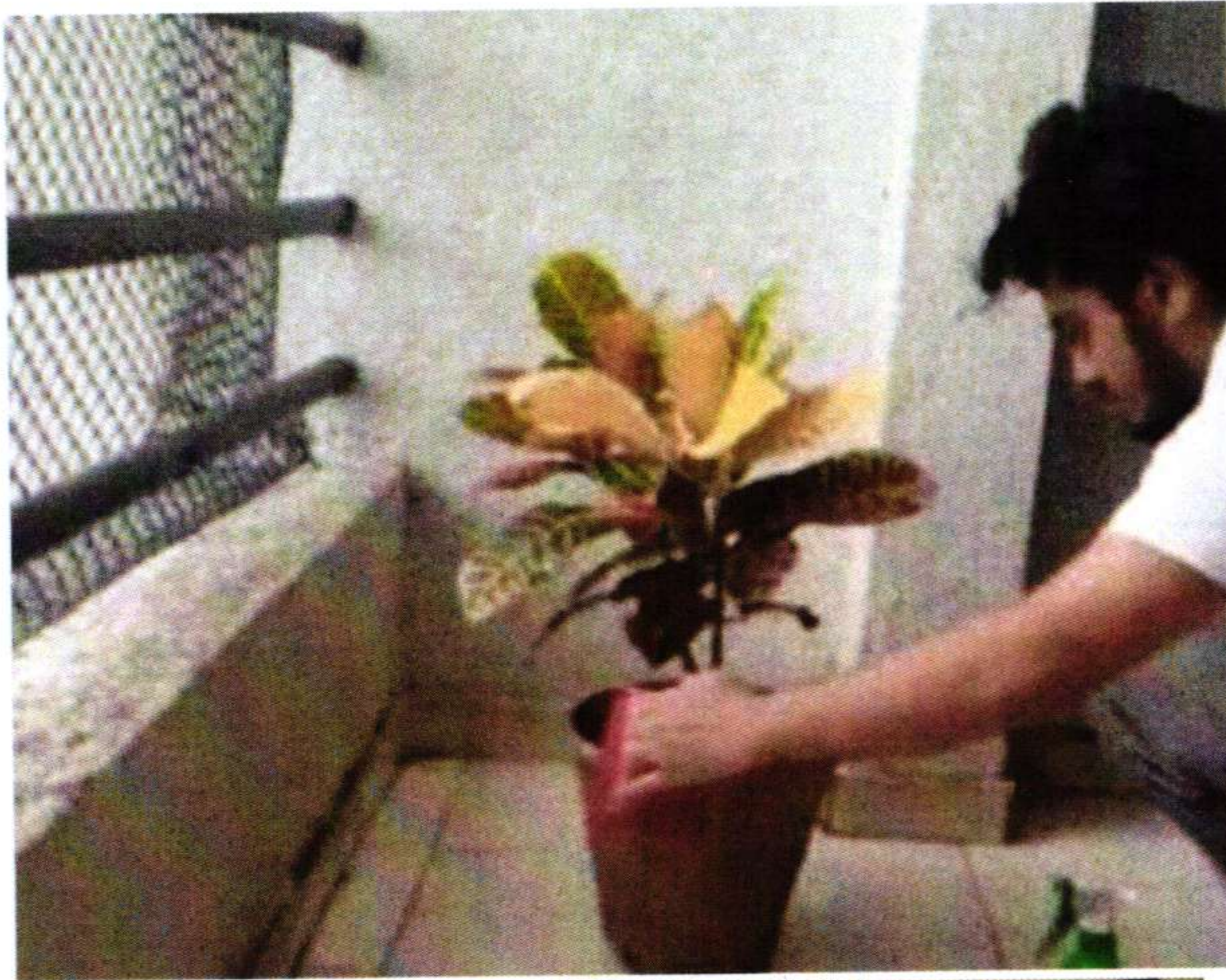

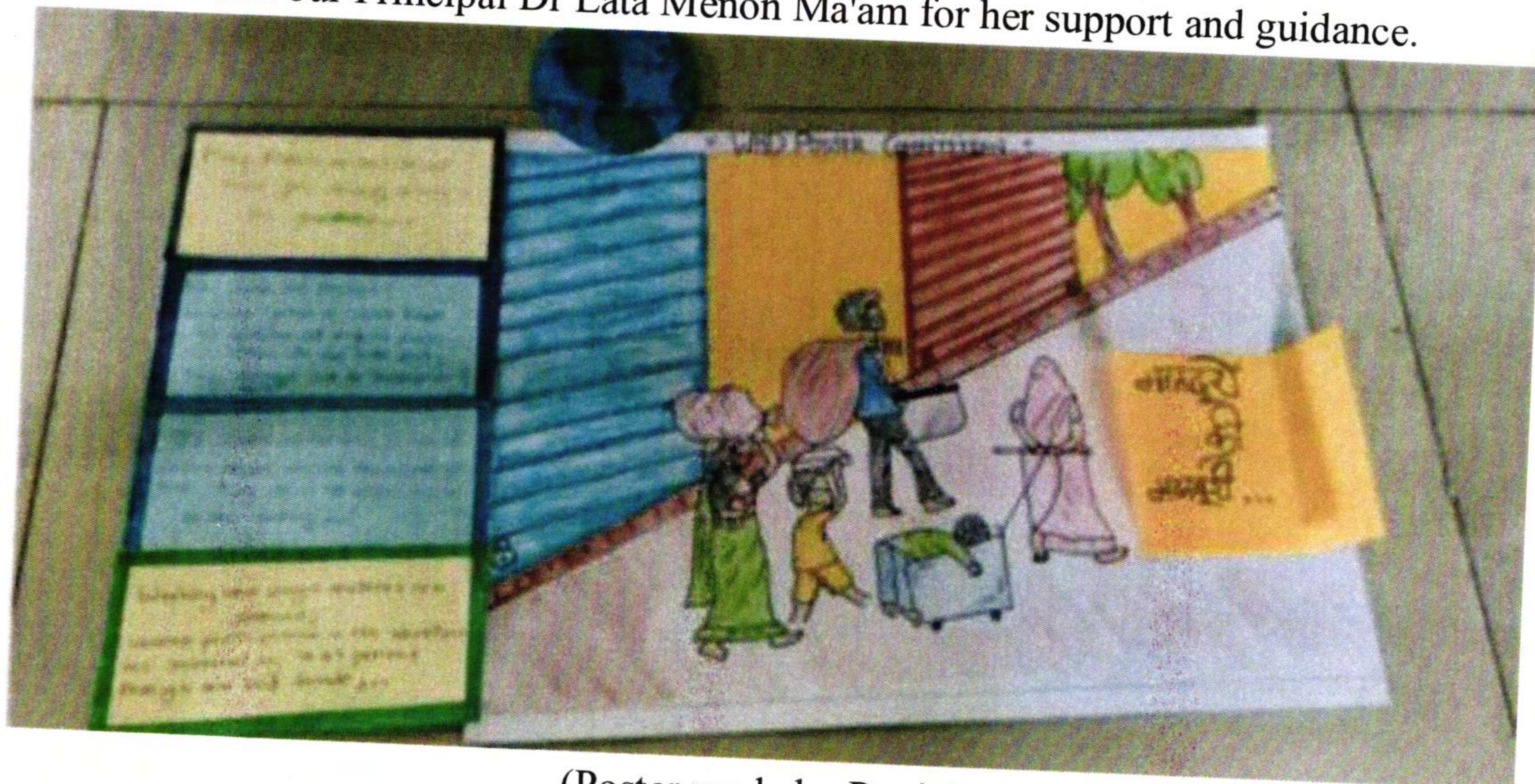
