	<u>Celebration – 2020</u>


Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of our college, in association with Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) Cell organised an Online Video Making Competition as a part of World Earth Day Celebration, on 22 April, 2020. The EVENT was a theme-based intercollegiate competition on "Mother Earth is Healing: The Brighter Side of COVID - 19!". Online registration google form links were shared as a part of the notification on the same to inculcate a positive view point among students during times of COVID -19 pandemic. The link was opened for registration from 22 April, 2020. The registration has to be closed with an overwhelming response of 290 entries coming in a single day. The submission date of the Videos was given as latest by 24 April, 2020 through mail id provided in the e-notification. The rules were summarized as size of video less than 10MB and time limit of 60 seconds. The video should be shot from indoors only.

Adhering to the timeline of submission we received 121 videos. The videos which did not follow the theme and mandatory rules were scraped. The judgement for the competition was completed in two rounds — Preliminary round and Final round. In the preliminary round, a panel of 7 faculty members were part of judging team. Final 75 videos were segregated and shared with the respective judges to allot marks depending on judgment criteria such as creativity, originality, technology, presentation and relevance to theme. The selected 14 videos were shared with panel of judges for final round. The panel for final round had 4 faculty members who finalised their decision after intense competition, screening and elimination. Top five videos were declared winners.


