 - 4) Each paper should have a cover page with the title of the paper, name of the author(s), affiliation of the author(s) and the contact details (Address, telephone number and email address of author).
 - 5) All notes / references must be serially numbered and given at the end. In case of website reference the entire URL should be provided by author(s).
 - 6) The conference proceedings will be published.
