Action Taken Report (ATR) 2018-19

- Positive Psychology sessions for the students were introduced by IQAC.
- One day Industrial Visit for students of all departments across all streams was organised on 7th September, 2018.

Prof. Mishkaat Imrani, of PCACS handled lectures for the SYBMM SEM IV students of our college for the paper “Mass Media Research”. Prof. Sindhuja Joshi, of our college handled lectures for the SYBMM SEM IV students of PCACS for the paper “Mass Media Research” and also TYBMS SEM VI students of PCACS for the paper “HRM in Global Perspective”
