5. Place your mobile or laptop in such a position that you can comfortably look at the video.

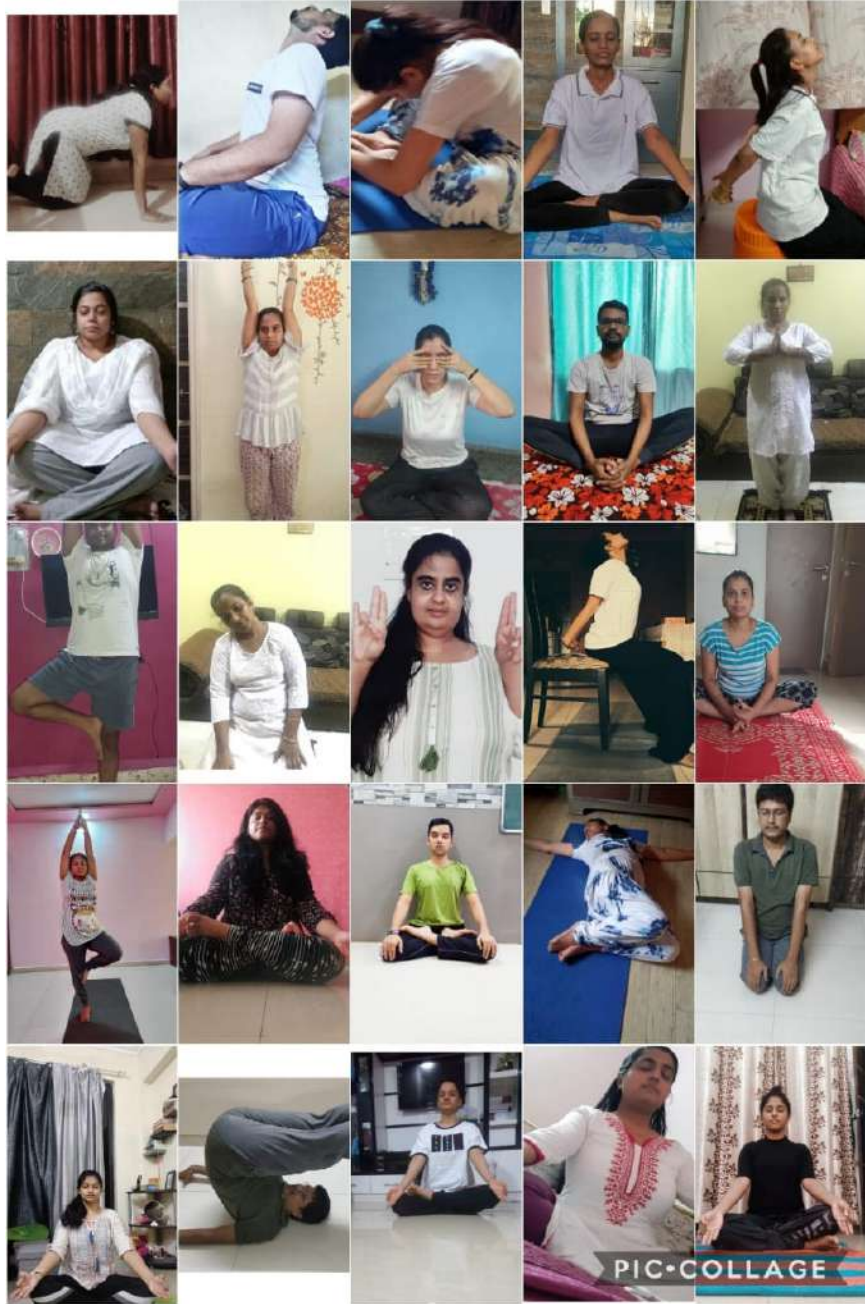

SESSION REPORTS

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Pillai HOC College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Rasayani had organized one-day online National Webinar on “**Quality Enhancement in Higher Education in India: An Introspection**” in collaboration with Guru Angad Dev Teaching Learning centre, University of Delhi on 28 May, 2021.

The Webinar was attended by 93 faculty members of different institutions across India. Asst. Prof. Ms. Remya Madangopal, the Convener for the programme as well as the head of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell, PHCASC introduced the idea behind organizing this event. She welcomed both the speakers with great enthusiasm and introduced their achievements to the audience.

Before the first session could take its course, Prof. Vimal Rarh, Project Head & Joint Director, GAD TLC, Delhi University, began to explain the concept of e-Pathshala. This centre for e-learning through e-content development at national level was introduced in October, 2013. She laid emphasis on 6 subjects (Chemistry, Commerce, Economics, Business Economics, Psychology & Forensic Science &) at Post-Graduate level which includes around 89 courses under this project initiated by UGC-MHRD, Govt. of India. Around 42 MOOCs were developed and uploaded on SWAYAM portal, which stood out to be the largest contribution by a single team at the national level. She explained the various programmes like FDPs, Refresher Courses that can be persuaded by anybody who wishes to do so through SWAYAM portal.

SESSION ONE:

The first session of the day was graced by the presence of Dr. A.K. Bakshi, Founder Vice Chancellor, PDM University, Haryana. He started off explaining the role of a teacher- Teaching, Research and Academic, Administration and Management. He also spoke about the recruitment of the teacher and asked the qualified ones to disseminate quality knowledge. He believes that the 21st century skills along with rigorous academic content can only lead to deeper learning. These skills he says includes the Learning Skills, the Literary Skills and the Life Skills. He rightly raised the concern that in spite of the rapid increase in the counts of Universities, Colleges, Teachers and Students from 1950-2019, taking India to the record of being the third largest education system in the world but still the fact is no Indian citizen have won the Noble Prize since 1930 (the last being C.V.Raman for his Raman Effect). He sees to it as a grave issue. He laid

more emphasis on Research and Development. For him, Perseverance, Resilience, Creativity, Open-mindedness and willingness to collaborate is the mantra for successful research.

Dr. Bakshi further moved ahead by questioning the Indian Education System with all its flaws. He strongly believes that our Education System needs to shift its focus from rote learning to encouraging thinking, innovation and creativity among students. He mentions the 6 level hierarchies (Remembering, Understanding, Applying, Analyzing, Evaluating and Creating). Dr. Bakshi feels that assessment should be made more scientific in its approach. He also threw his weight behind the MOOCs which definitely he says, **Best of the Country addressing the rest.** He put to rest the growing fear of the teachers whether technology will replace teachers. He says NO as a reply to this question. He stated that **Technology will never replace great Teachers but technology in the hands of great teachers is transformational.**

According to him there is a new role for teachers now in the higher education system.

They must –

1. Be tech savvy
2. Manage virtual classrooms and discussion forums
3. Be proficient in development of e-content and MOOCs.

He further continues by asking 21st century teachers to be smarter in thinking, be creative and always go for out of the box ideas, should have sound subject knowledge along with clarity of the concepts, develop the better pedagogy to make their learners understand the subject most appropriately. The other add-on skills like good communication, presentation attributes, Writing Skills, ICT Skills and Proactive personality is must. Dr. Bakshi beautifully described the difference between Personality and Character. He quotes- **A ship is safe in Harbor but that's not what Ships are built for.** Same way, he explains that Humans are not designed to be happy in status quo and continuous dissatisfaction can lead to better and better opportunities as one face tensions and pressures. Another captivating quote drawn by him was- **A bird sitting on a tree is never afraid of the branch breaking because her trust is not on the branch but on her own wings.** This alludes his thoughts better which says Always believe in yourself. For, he believes in not being Arrogant, which breeds out of Ego, but in Self belief which breeds ones Confidence. With some beautiful old Bollywood melodies (inspirational songs), he signed off for Question and Answer session. The audience quenched their queries by throwing their doubts which was

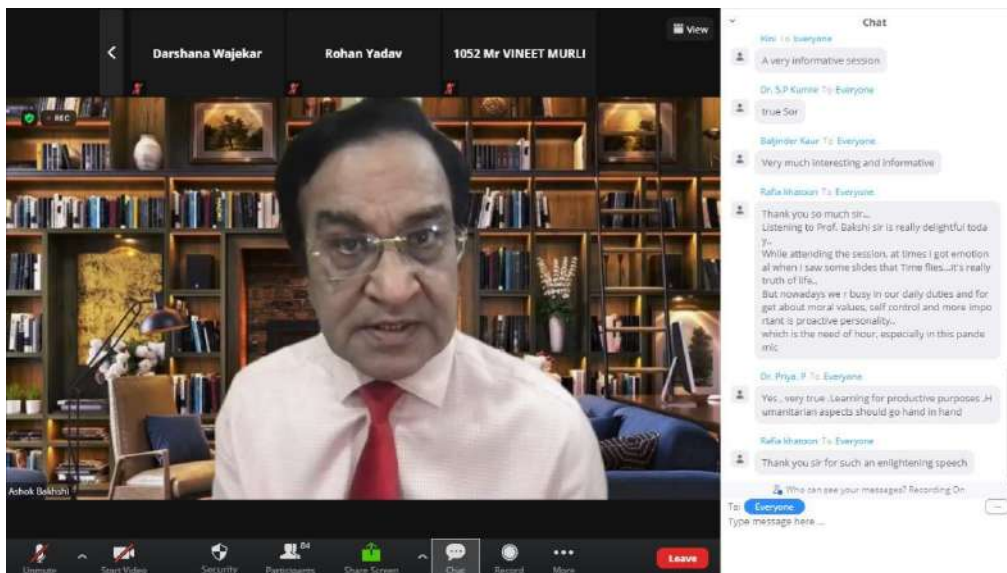
graciously answered by the speaker. The Vote of Thanks was proposed by Ms. Rewati Soma, the Faculty and Head of the Department Commerce.

SESSION TWO:

Exactly after few minutes time the second session started with the next Resource person, Prof. Vimal Rarh, Project Head & Joint Director, GAD TLC, Delhi University was introduced to the audience by Ms. Sweta Choudhary, Faculty and Head of Department of Bachelor of Accountancy and Finance. Prof. Vimal Rarh started by explaining how to **Empower Teachers for Outcome Based Education**. The speaker stressed the need to lay more emphasis on CO, PO and PSO outcomes. It was her observation that there is a need to measure all these outcomes to have a proper understanding of the applied teaching methodologies. She feels that that there is also a need to transfer the teaching pedagogy from teacher centric to the learner centric mode. For her, she expects to know what the learners learnt, understood and must be able to finish their program of study. The Graduate Outcomes at UGC includes: Disciplinary Knowledge, Communication Skills, Critical Thinking, Problem Solving, Analytical Reasoning, Research related Skills, Cooperation and Team work and Scientific Reasoning. The speaker was more interested in explaining the Blended Learning for Outcome Based Education to the onlookers. She talks of how Curriculum and Content development, Blended teaching and learning, Assessment as well as Periodic programme review have changed the modern approach in teaching and learning. Thus the Learning Outcomes are must for us to do any justice towards the learners. She very perfectly explained the importance of MOOCs too. These courses she say is unlimited, no qualification criteria is imposed except for grades, the study is done through web and it holds one semester paper. To add on, she has promoted the SWAYAM portal and asked the learners to explore more on the online platform. ICT was also one more area where Prof. Vimal Rarh had constant eye on since the modern teachers cannot live in complete ignorance of the modern technology. The tech savvy teachers are the need of an hour and they must adapt or perish. Multimedia enriched presentations will also lead the learners perform miracles because than they will rack their brain to know the unknown. She hence encouraged all to develop the e-contents and recorded videos. The e-contents have to be correct, technically specified ones and should have positive outlook. This combinations altogether than can definitely provide a very good quality e-content. Her brain child- Teacher's e-Kit 2.0 for the integration of subject, ICT tools and Pedagogy for Blended Teaching-Learning process was the remarkable feat which can help the modern educators in the days to come. With patient replies

and graceful action, Prof. Vimal Rarh won the hearts of the audience. Later, Mr. Rohan Yadav, the Faculty, gave the vote of thanks to close the session for the day.

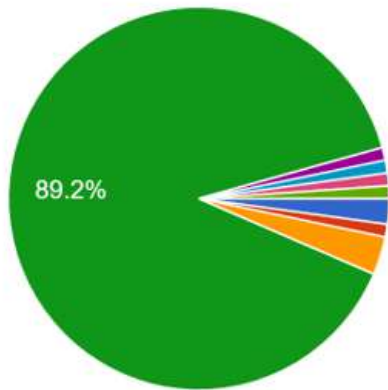

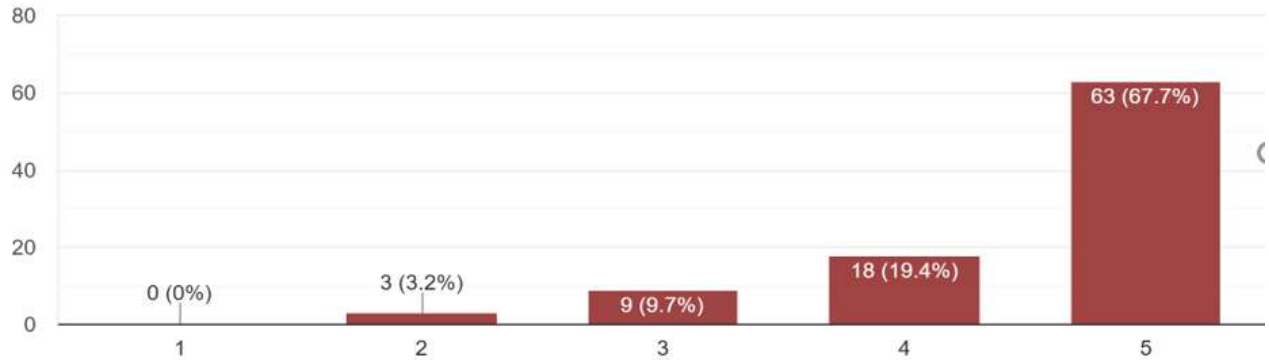

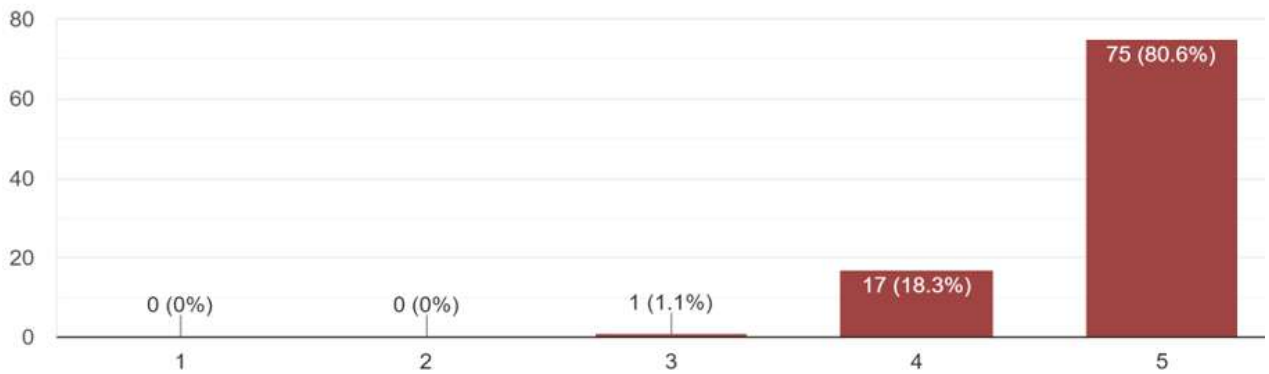

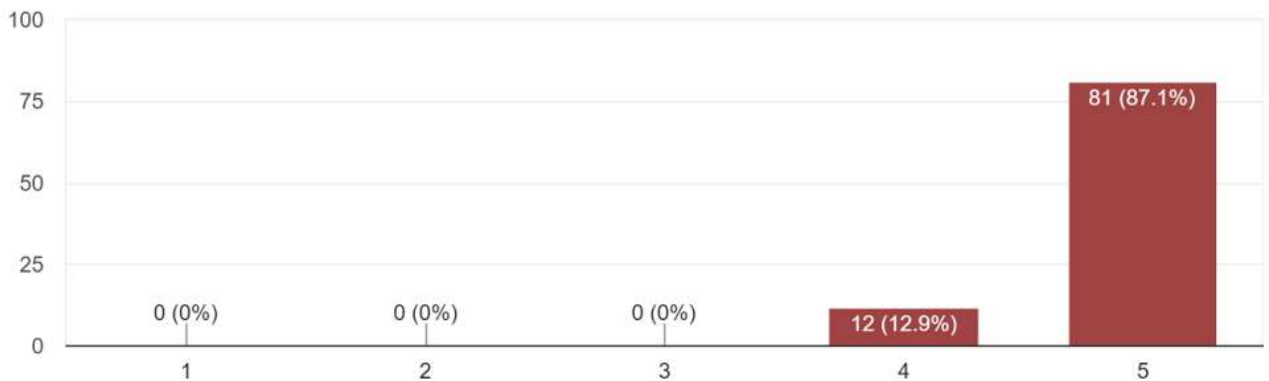

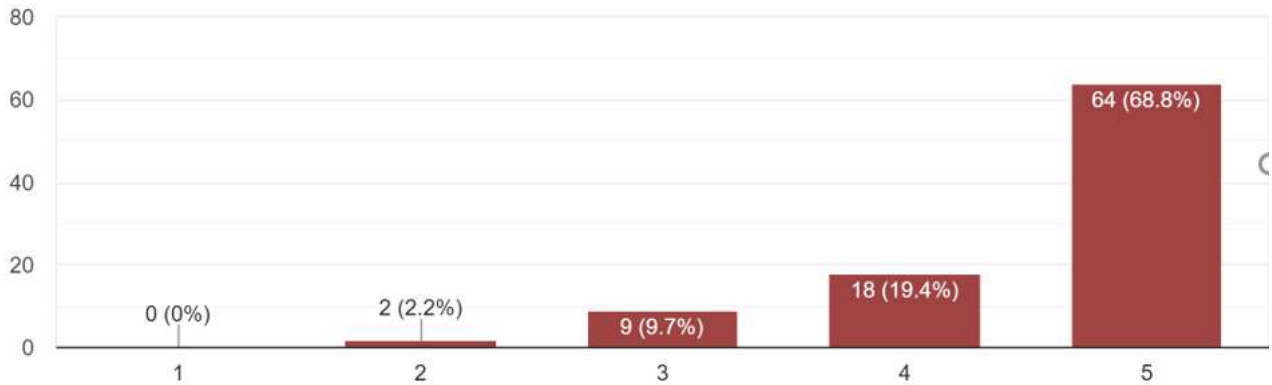

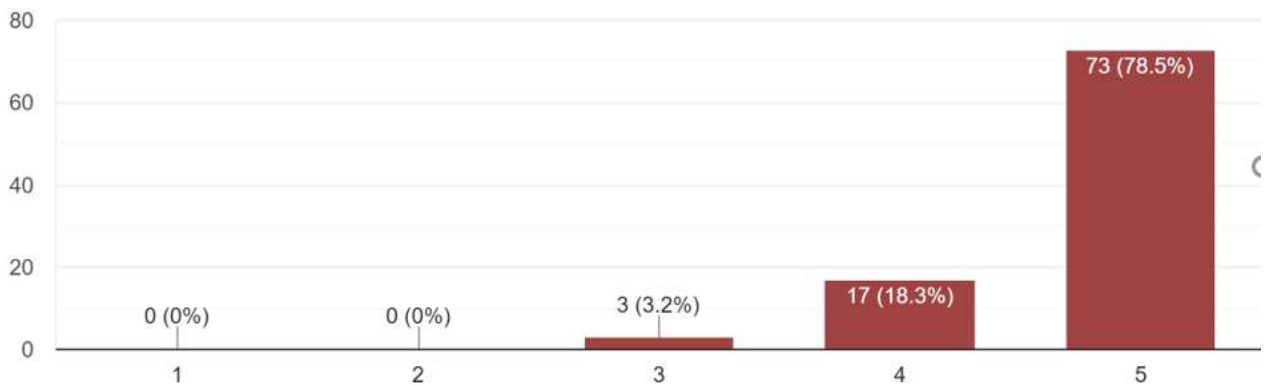
