Report:-

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Mahatma Education Society's Pillai HOC College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Rasayani organised an Interactive Expert Guidance Session on Accreditation and Assessment Framework by NAAC on August 04, 2021 (Wednesday). The objective of this programme is to discuss and analyse the revised framework of NAAC SSR and the responses of the institution against Quantitative Metrics (QnM) of various criteria in NAAC Self Study Report (SSR).

The resource person for the event was Dr. M. P. Rajan, NAAC Advisor (Rtd.), Bengaluru. The event started off with a warm welcome address by IQAC coordinator Ms. Remya Madan Gopal. During the welcome address, IQAC Coordinator stressed the relevance of the day's event and welcomed the guest of honour, principle, and other staff members wholeheartedly. The principal of our college, Dr. Lata Menon introduced the resource person and briefed on various achievements in his overwhelmingly successful career. Madam felicitated Dr. M. P. Rajan as a token of our love and appreciation. The core session started with general address and a brief outline on NAAC evaluation process, which primarily involved around SSR, Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) and peer team visit as pointed out by the resource person.

Dr. M. P. Rajan briefed the process and followed by his in-depth analysis of all quantitative metrics as the qualitative indicator framework in NAAC accreditation process starting with Criterion I. Sir suggested the relevance of add on courses or certificate courses and participation of students for the same along with highlighting the feedback mechanism on curricular aspects. Our invited speaker moved on to Criterion II, stressing on its elaborate weightage in accreditation and significantly underlined the importance of evaluating course and program outcomes and meticulous planning of student satisfaction survey. After an elaborate analysis of first two criteria the participants were informed of a session break for lunch.

The post lunch session started off with guidance and suggestions on criterion III. In here, the speaker stressed on publications and developing innovative ecosystem which would cater research aptitude young students and faculty members. The focus was also on extension activities organised by the college. The guest deeply analysed infrastructure details along with relevance of strong and advanced library facilities to be provided for the students for their overall development in Criterion IV. The resource person also pointed the need involvement of alumni and strengthen the key indicator of alumni engagements along with highlighting the functions and policies of placement cell in the college in Criterion V. Student support and progression and importance of sessions or centres for training and coaching students to prepare for competitive examinations was suggested to be worked on in the future.

In criterion VI, the major attention was given to governance and leadership and faculty empowerment programmes. The final Criterion VII, which included best practices and institutional distinctiveness was discussed on to provide how to internalise and institutionalise practices that will bring about strong positive impacts among students. the success rate of such practices shall be evaluated, to put forth evidentiary support. The guest speaker provided detailed input and analysis of metrics which are to be improved and pointed out the strong areas where the college is successful

in implementing NAAC guidelines. The session was informative with innumerable take away points to be discussed by IQAC in detail and tackle the same, with planning and support of management. The event concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Mr. Sujith Babu, IQAC Coordinator who appreciated and expressed sincere gratitude to the resource person for his valuable insights and precise evaluation on various metrics. The suggestions would help us in great extent while submitting the Self Study Report for second cycle of NAAC in the coming academic year. The event ended with national anthem. The participants provided positive and impactful feedback on the session and we are also very thankful for clarifying the doubts in various metrics in their respective criteria.

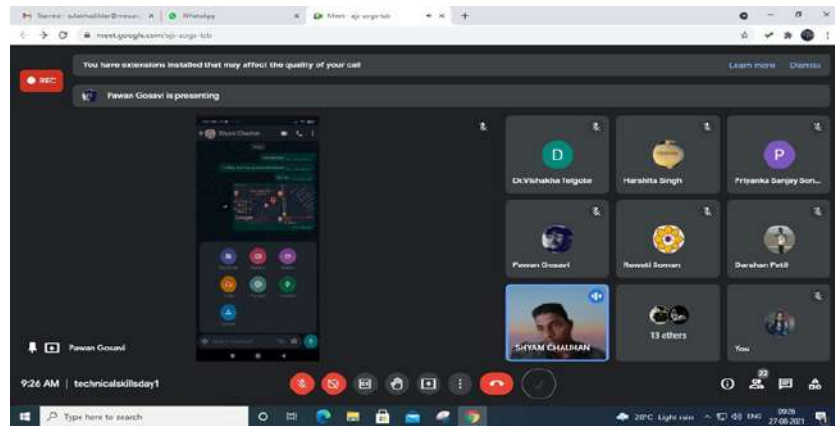
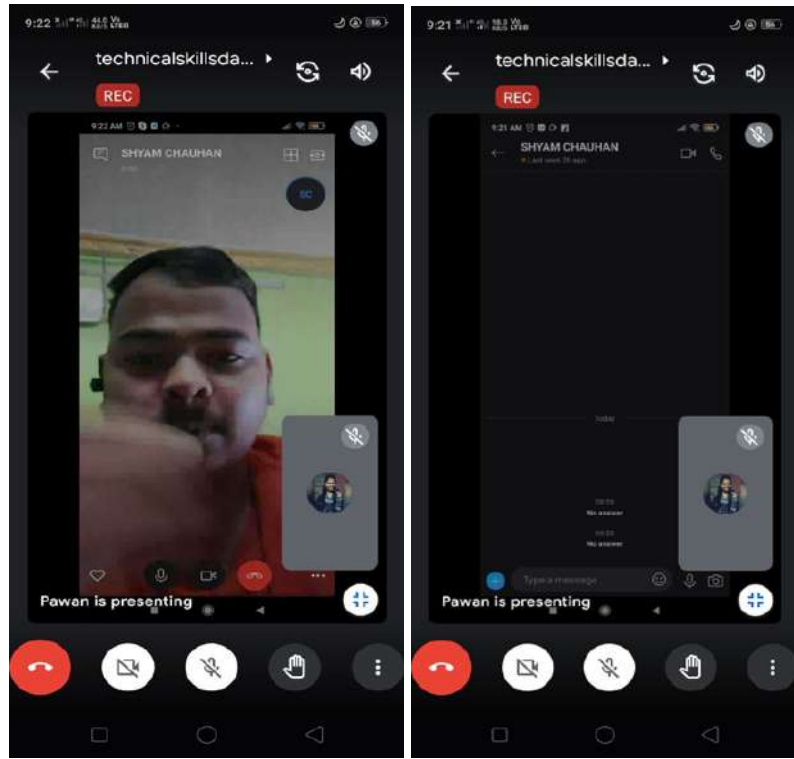
The Day2 started with Miss. Sulbha Nandeshwar welcoming and introducing the resource person.

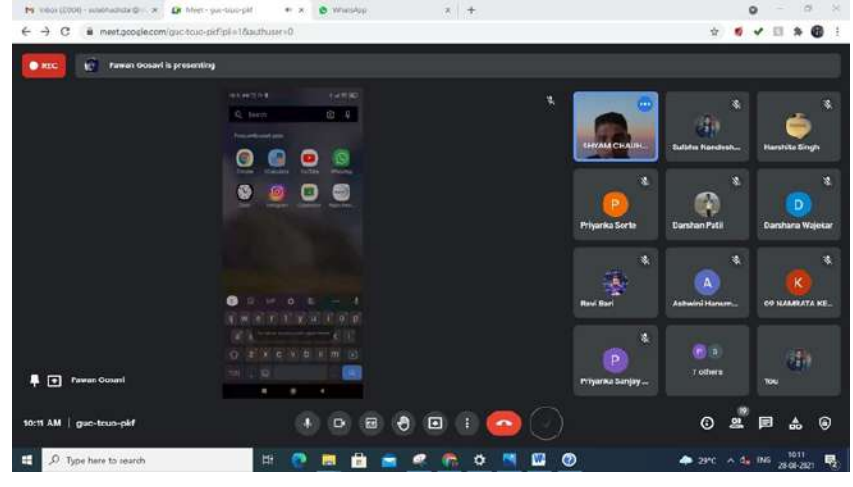
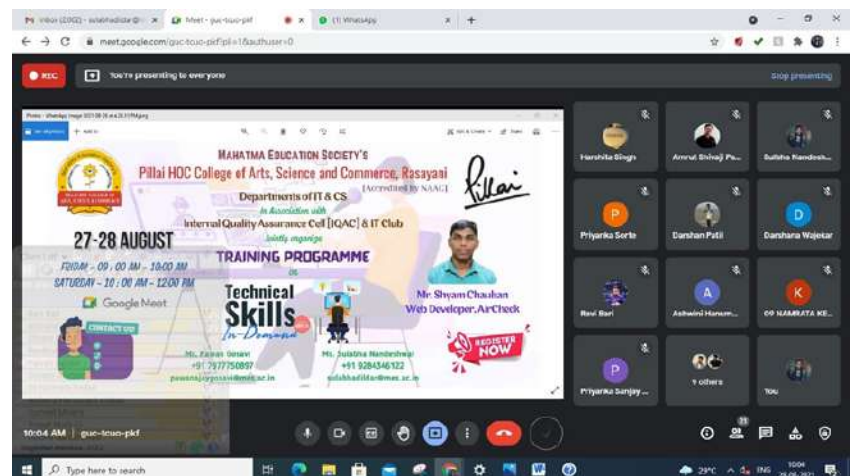
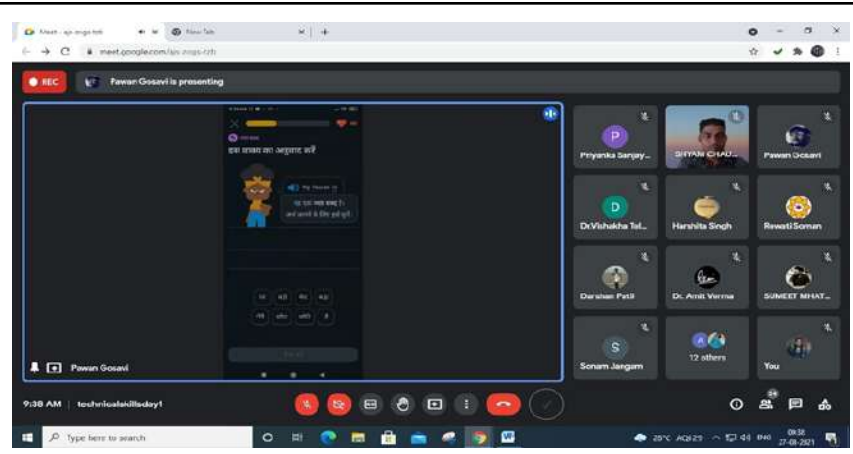

Day 5: Bloom’s Taxonomy in Teaching, Learning and Evaluation

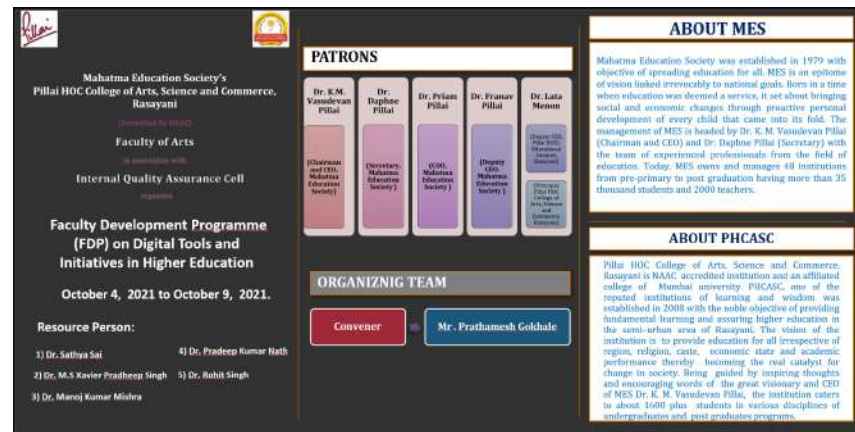
