


1. Orientation Programme- Faculty of Arts

Digital Tools and Initiatives in Higher Education

Mentioned below are the topics covered in the FDP:

Day 1: *Technology-Augmented Learning Process: An Introduction*

The speaker of the session was Dr. K. Sathya Sai. He introduced and explained various aspects related to how technology has changed the learning curve and the various challenges that can be overcome. He received positive feedback from the participants for his session.

Day 2: *LMS and other E-Learning Options*

The speaker for the session was Dr. M.S. Xavier Pradheep Singh. He expounded very well on the various applications and digital tools available to make teaching online interactive and fun. The participants did show much interest and were excited to use the tools he explained through the share screen option on Zoom.

Day 3: *Blended Learning: A Path to the New Normal*

The speaker of the session was Prof. (Dr) Manoj Kumar Mishra. He spoke about how learning has undergone changes and the ways teachers need to assess and tackle the situation.

Day 4: *Enhancing LSRW: A Pragmatic Approach in Bloom's Taxonomy*


Day 6: Valedictory Session



5. Webinar on „Intellectual Property Rights-Copyrights and Licenses


6. Movie Screening - Ek Ruka Hua Faisla

7. One Day Online National Conference on „Understanding Trauma: Response and Recovery in Text, Culture and Rhetorics“





9. A Webinar Digital Marketing - Career Opportunities in New Age Media




10. A Webinar on Aspects of Journalism





12. ALUMNI GUIDANCE SESSION


2. ORIENTATION PROGRAMME Department of Computer Science for SY and TY Students(Conducted by : Department of CS on June 17, 2021)




13. Webinar on 'Research Methodology: „Approach to Scopus Publications: Insights“

16. One Week Orientation programme for First year students in AY 2021-22




The student participation was remarkable.








5. LIBRARY ORIENTATION PROGRAMME FOR A.Y. 2021-22 –SYBSc (Information Technology on December 02, 2021




16. A Guidance Session on “Competitive Examinations in Chemical Sciences” (Conducted by Department of Chemistry, PHCASC on February 26, 2022)

Day 6: Topic- „Me“ to „We“





Principle of NMR Spectroscopy

- Electromagnetic radiation of long wavelength (1000cm to 10000cm) in radiofrequency region interact with certain nuclei in presence of strong external magnetic field.
- Unlike electron, nucleus also has its spin quantum number.
- Nucleus behave as a tiny bar magnet and are random spinning in the absence of external applied magnetic field.
- However when placed in strong applied magnetic field, it will have 2 possible orientation.
- It can either orient its magnetic moment in the direction of the applied magnetic field or against it.
- The energy required to flip a proton from low energy spin state to high energy spin state depend upon the strength of magnetic field and is given by

$$\Delta E = h\nu = \gamma \hbar B_0$$



Webinar on „Research Methodology: Selection of a research topic“




One day webinar on Intellectual Property Rights-Patent, Department of BCOM (A & F)


The Art of Publishing in Indexed Journals.,Department of B.COM (A & F),October 9, 2021



Expert Lecture on „Registration of GST“, Department of B.Com (Accounting & Finance), October 29, 2021





VIRTUAL FIELD VISIT , April 11, 2022



It is an Indian company that manufactures, markets and sells milk and milk products.

With an aim to go beyond academics, field visit was planned for students to give a practical perspective of corporate functioning.

Parag Milk Foods started as a dairy in Manchar with a 20,000 litre capacity in 1992. It concentrated on a niche segment, producing skimmed milk powder and by 2004 became India's largest exporter of the skimmed milk powder. However, the company faced a challenge when the Government of India banned export of milk powder on account of local milk shortage. The company is India's second largest producer of cheese under its brand *Go* and the country's largest producer of cow ghee under its brand *Gowardhan*.

The students were able to know about how company maintains accounting and marketing records. They were able to understand the production process of ghee, curds, paneer and cheese. It was exciting experience to see the packing process of all different dairy products. Their marketing and promotion strategies are very impressive. Interview with the managing Director well explained the growth and development of the company in last decade.



The Art of Publishing in Indexed Journals.,Department of B.COM (A & F),October 9, 2021

The event ended with a formal Vote of Thanks by Ms. Mitali Patra, Student of the Department.








Expert Lecture on „Registration of GST“, Department of B.Com (Accounting & Finance),

All the staff and students motivated the participants by visiting their stalls, purchasing the goods and playing games. The participants made profits from their stalls and their efforts were commendable.





Parag Milk Foods. It is an Indian company that manufactures, markets and sells milk and milk products.

Objectives of the virtual field visit are to provide students an insight regarding internal working of company. As theoretical knowledge is not enough for making a good professional career, it is supported by live experience. With an aim to go beyond academics, field visit was planned for students to give a practical perspective of corporate functioning.

Parag Milk Foods started as a dairy in Manchar with a 20,000 litre capacity in 1992. It concentrated on a niche segment, producing skimmed milk powder and by 2004 became India's largest exporter of the skimmed milk powder. However, the company faced a challenge when the Government of India banned export of milk powder on account of local milk shortage. The company is India's second largest producer of cheese under its brand *Go* and the country's largest producer of cow ghee under its brand *Gowardhan*.

The students were able to know about how company maintains accounting and marketing records. They were able to understand the production process of ghee, curds, paneer and cheese. It was exciting experience to see the packing process of all different dairy products. Their marketing and promotion strategies are very impressive. Interview with the managing Director well explained the growth and development of the company in last decade.



IQAC Activities 2021-22


1. In-house Guidance Session on Accreditation and Assessment

She systematically made participants acquainted with all seven criteria & gave awareness to participants about their importance in the A & A process.

2. An Interactive Expert Guidance Session on Accreditation and Assessment Framework by NAAC

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Mahatma Education Society's Pillai HOC College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Rasayani organised an Interactive Expert Guidance Session on Accreditation and Assessment Framework by NAAC on August 04, 2021 (Wednesday). The objective of this programme is to discuss and analyse the revised framework of NAAC SSR and the responses of the institution against Quantitative Metrics (QnM) of various criteria in NAAC Self Study Report

(SSR).

The resource person for the event was Dr. M. P. Rajan, NAAC Advisor (Rtd.), Bengaluru. The event started off with a warm welcome address by IQAC coordinator Ms. Remya Madan Gopal. During the welcome address, IQAC Coordinator stressed the relevance of the day's event and welcomed the guest of honour, principle, and other staff members wholeheartedly. The principal of our college, Dr. Lata Menon introduced the resource person and briefed on various achievements in his overwhelmingly successful career. Madam felicitated Dr. M. P. Rajan as a token of our love and appreciation. The core session started with general address and a brief outline on NAAC evaluation process, which primarily involved around SSR, Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) and peer team visit as pointed out by the resource person.





